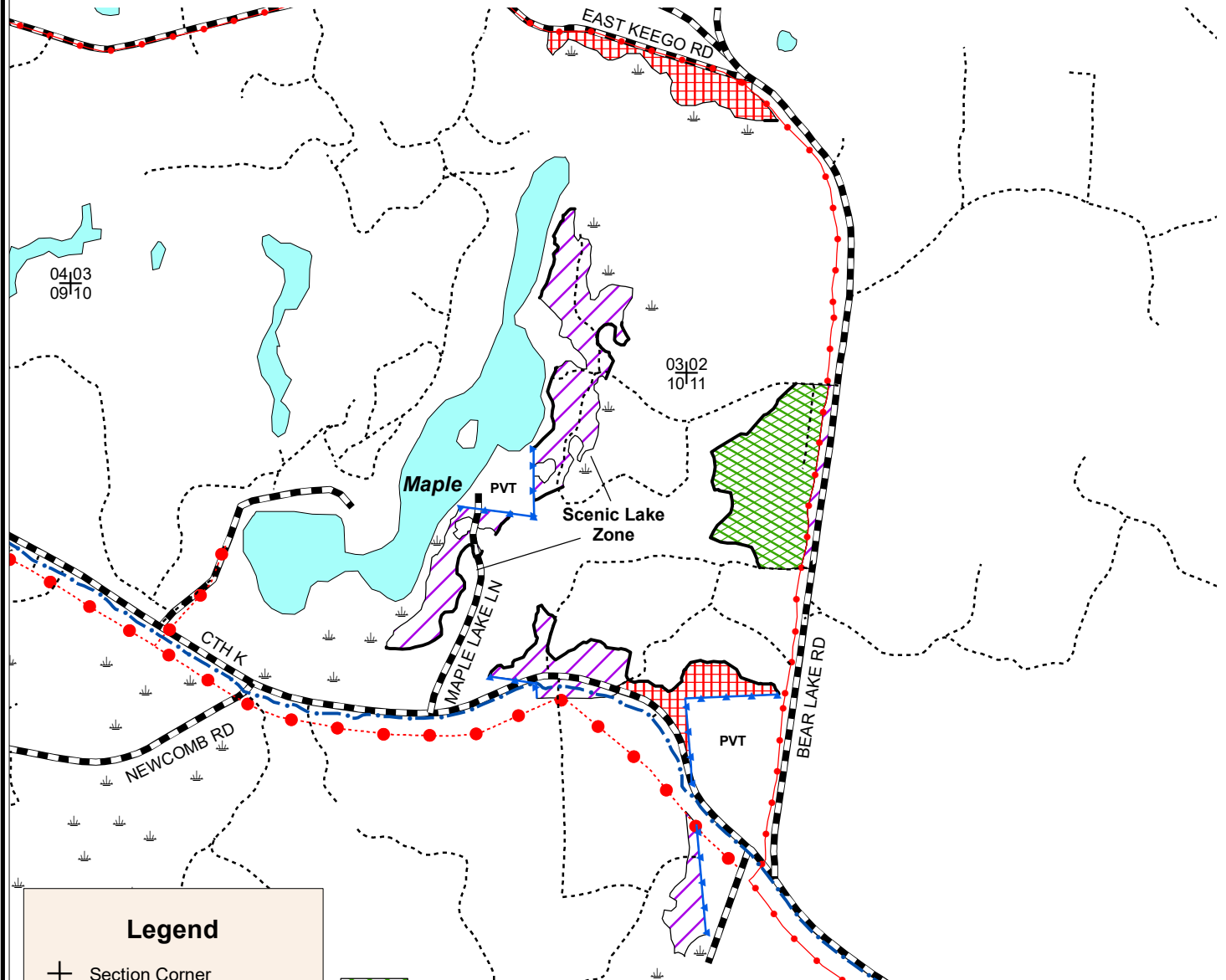

**Oak Shelterwood Area (22 Acres):** Cut all trees greater than 1 inch, EXCEPT trees marked with green paint.



**Conifer Area (15 Acres):** Cut all balsam fir, maple, aspen, ironwood and trees marked with orange paint. All balsam fir greater than 1 inch will be cut in the southern block to prepare site for interplanting.



**Hardwood Area (41 Acres):** Cut all balsam fir, aspen, ironwood and trees marked with orange paint.

No bid bond is required.

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 78 acres.

The contract period is 2 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Whole Tree harvest is not allowed.

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<sup>1</sup> Red Pine is approximately 72% red pine and 28% white pine. (wt. conv. 2.206 tons/cord).

Potential for 17 MBF of red pine and 5 MBF of white pine sawlogs.

<sup>2</sup> Mixed Hardwood is approximately 42% white birch, 30% hard maple, 26% red maple, 1% basswood, and 1% ironwood.  
(wt. conv. 2.402 tons/cord).

Potential for 7 MBF of hard maple, 6 MBF of white birch, 5 MBF of red maple, and 3 MBF of basswood sawlogs.

Note: Total sale volume equates to 45.9 tons/acre or 18.2 cords/acre.

Special Conditions

1. Slash adjacent to roads must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground. Pull back at least ten feet behind tree line.
2. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
3. No harvest activities allowed April 15 – July 15 due to risk of oak wilt.
4. All pine products cut between May 1st and September 1st must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from the time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to May 1st of each year.
5. No equipment allowed within 15 feet of ephemeral ponds or wetlands.
6. Do not cut, knock down, or utilize any dead trees unless they pose an operational safety risk.
7. No landings or decking of wood products will be allowed within the 400-foot Scenic Lake Zone.
