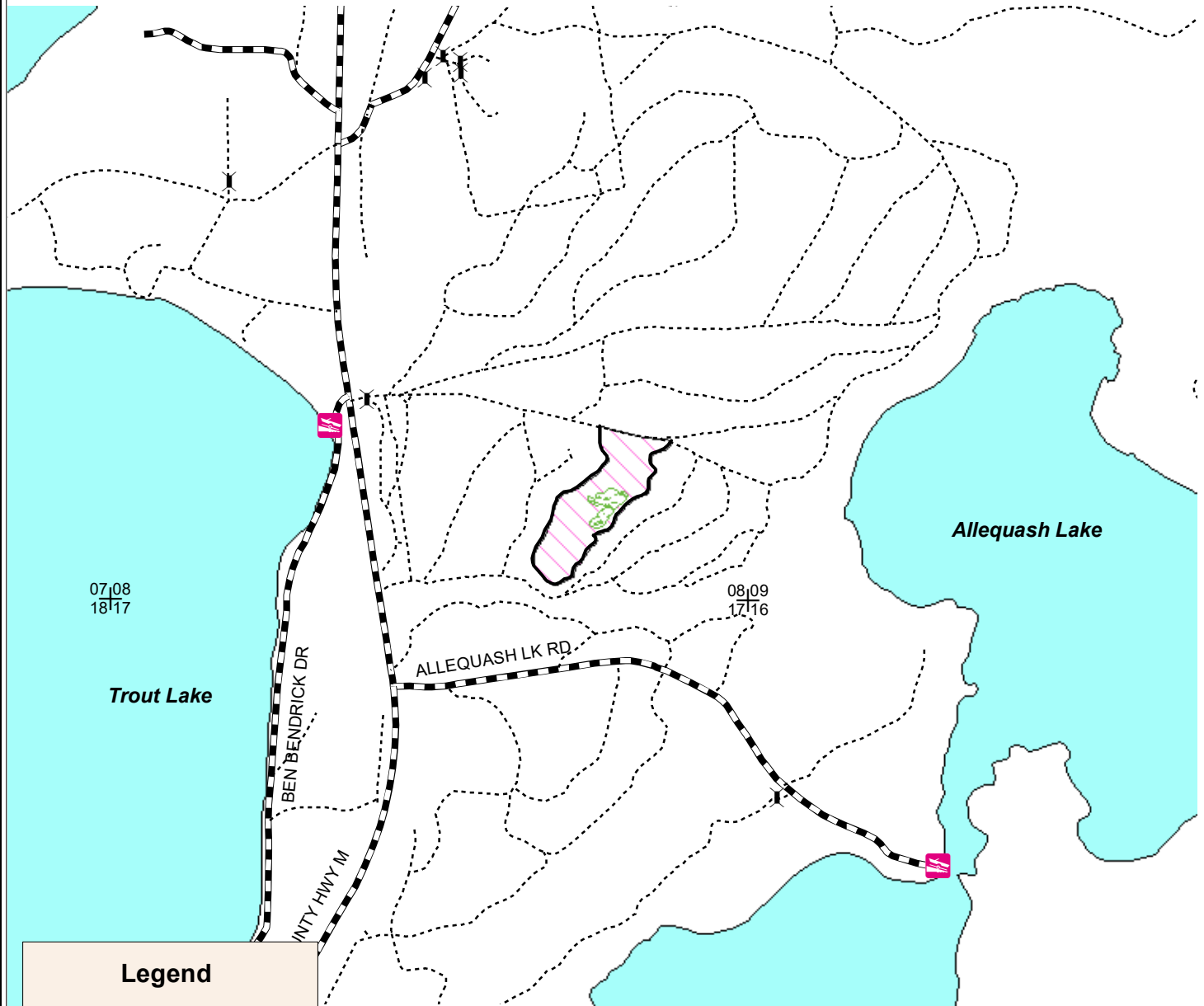

Timber Sale Area (14 Acres): Cut all orange marked trees. Take care to not damage oak and maple regeneration.

Note: Seasonal Restriction - No harvesting or road building activities between April 15 - July 15 due to Oak Wilt restrictions. Oak Wilt restrictions are in place to protect surrounding oak stands, as well as protect the advanced regeneration in the understory.

No Place Like Home Pine

Vilas County

Town 41 North, Range 7E Section 8

No bid bond required.

15% of the total sale bid value or \$1,000.00, whichever is greater, will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 10 acres.

The contract period is 2 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to a minimum top diameter of 4" will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree harvest is not allowed.

¹ Volume includes 96% red pine 4% white pine. It also includes 40 MBF of potential red pine logs.

Special Conditions

1. No slash allowed across red line, or within any wetland. Slash must be lopped and scattered to lay within 2 feet of the ground and pulled back into the sale area at least 10 feet away from roads.
2. All landings and any new woods roads must be approved by sale administrator.
3. All pine products cut between May 1st and September 1st must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from the time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to May 1st of each year.
4. No Logging Activity or road building allowed from April 15th – July 15th due to the risk of Oak Wilt.
5. **Special care must be taken to protect oak regeneration.** Processor shall fall trees in the direction of travel to the extent possible. Only short wood forwarding allowed. Forwarder must follow the same path as the processor to the extent possible
