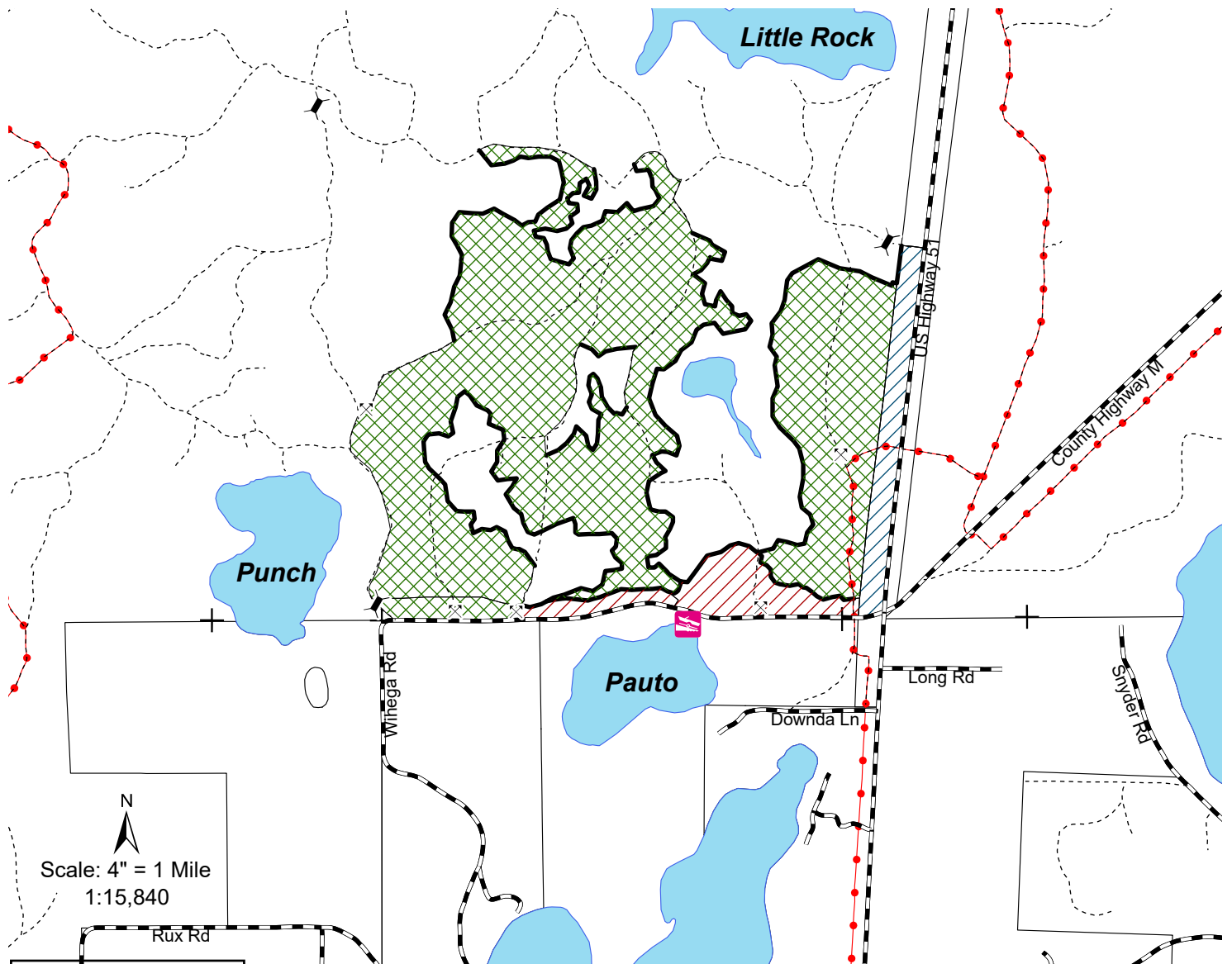

Oak Area (196 Acres): Cut only those oak not marked with green paint.



Hardwood Area (17 Acres): Cut all merchantable balsam and orange marked trees.



ROW Thinning (14 Acres): Cut all merchantable aspen, birch, balsam fir, and orange marked trees.

**No harvesting will be allowed between April 15th  
and July 15th due to oak wilt restrictions**

Section 35 – SE1/4; S1/2NE1/4; SENW; E1/2SW1/4; NWSW

Section 36 – W1/2SW1/4; SWNW

No bid bond is required.

15% of the total sale bid value or \$1000.00, whichever is greater, will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 227 acres.

The contract period is 3 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

<sup>1</sup> Approximately 68% red pine, 25% balsam fir, and 7% white pine. Includes potential for 17 MBF red pine and 3 MBF white pine sawlogs. (Wt. conv. 2.206 tons/cord)

<sup>2</sup> Includes potential for 700 MBF of red oak sawlogs.

<sup>3</sup> Approximately 70% aspen, 17% hard maple, 10% red maple, and 2% white birch. (Wt. conv. 2.301 tons/cd)

Note: Total sale volume equates to 36.6 tons/acre or 13.5 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. **Seasonal Restriction:** No cutting, skidding, or road building from April 15<sup>th</sup> to July 15<sup>th</sup> due to the risk of oak wilt.
2. All pine products cut between May 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to May 1 of each year.
3. Cutting must be concurrent for all species.
4. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees.
5. Slash within 50 feet of all roads and trails must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and be pulled back 10 feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.
6. The snowmobile trail must be kept free of debris, snow covered in winter, and generally be left in good condition at all times.
