The cutting area is approximately 79 acres.

The contract period is <u>3</u> years. <u>**NOTE: If this sale is granted an extension, the stumpage price will be increased by 15%**</u> All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized. Whole tree harvest <u>is</u> allowed on this timber sale.

The following is based upon volumes to a 4" top:

1\Balsam Fir – Approximately 575 tons Balsam Fir and 95 tons White Spruce; included in this volume is approximately 11 MBF of
White Spruce. Weighted average = 2.113 tons/cord.

2\Mixed Hardwood – Approximately 284 tons Red Maple, 67 tons Sugar Maple, 15 tons Ironwood and 8 tons ash; included in this volume is approximately 4 MBF of Sugar Maple. Weighted average = 2.339 tons/cord.

Sale contains approximately 59.9 tons/acre or 27.2 cords/acre.

Special Conditions

- 1. SEASONAL RESTRICTION: Harvest activity allowed only between November 1 through March 15.
- Timber mats are required to be used at the location shown on the timber sale map. The use of tops and/or pulp sticks will not be sufficient to cross the drainage, even under frozen ground conditions. Mats are available at the Trout Lake Forestry Headquarters.
- 3. All landings and any new roads must be approved prior to sale start up. All roads must be cleared of debris and leveled upon sale completion.
- 4. Slash within 50 feet of the Town Road must be lopped and scattered within 2 feet of the ground and pulled back at least 10 feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.
- 5. Do not operate machinery within 15 feet of any ephemeral pond or wetland and do not deposit any slash or tops in them.
