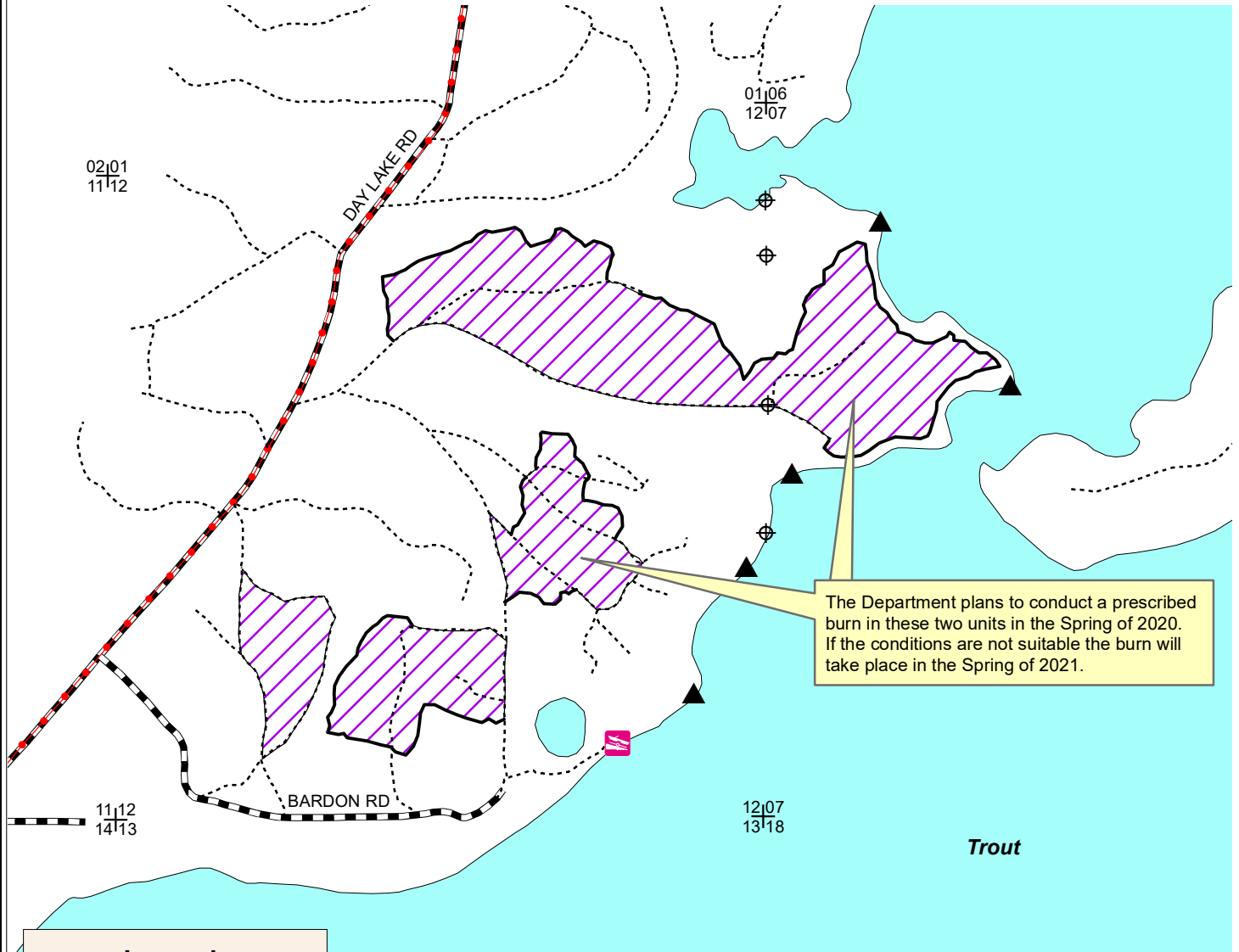

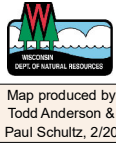

Harvest Area (155 Acres): Cut all oak NOT marked with yellow paint. Cut all pine marked with orange paint. Keep all slash at least 15 feet from the base of the trees left uncut.

All stands are within Mgmt. Area 3:  
Vilas Sandy Plains North -  
Forest Production

**Note: Seasonal Restriction - No harvest activity allowed between April 15 and July 15 in order to prevent establishment of oak wilt.**

The cutting area is approximately 155 acres.

The contract period is 3 years. \*\*Note: If this sale is granted an extension, the stumpage price will be increased by 15%\*\*.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4” top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree harvest is not allowed.

1\ Red Oak – Approximately 96% Red Oak, 3% White Pine and less than 1% Red Pine. Weight conversion: 2.719 tons/cord. Sale contains approximately 30.9 tons/acre or 12.9 cords/acre.

Special Conditions

1. All harvesting and skidding activity will only be allowed between July 15 and April 15 due to the risk of oak wilt.
2. All landings and any new roads must be approved prior to sale start up. All roads must be restored to pre-harvest condition upon sale completion.
3. All pine products cut between May 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to May 1 of each year.
