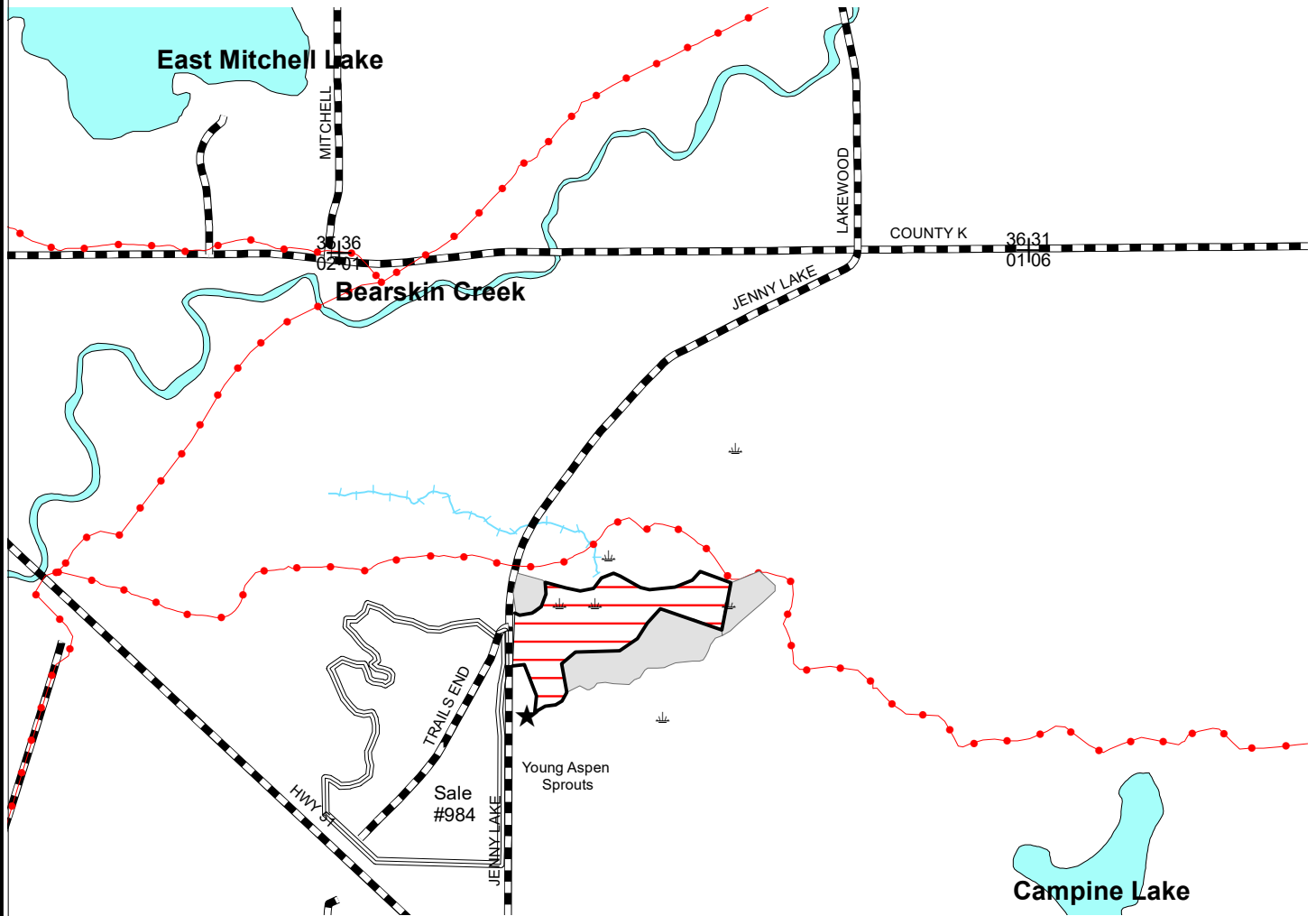

Harvest Area (17 acres): Winter harvest only. Cut all tamarack, black spruce, and balsam fir greater than 1 inch. All tops and limbs must lie less than two feet high. Uncut islands, consisting of 10 to 15 trees greater than 5 inches, must be left every 200 feet, evenly distributed throughout the stand.

Special Conditions

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
2. No equipment may be operated within 15 feet of any wetland unless the ground is firm or frozen. All slash to be lopped and scattered to lie within two feet of the ground. No tops or slash allowed across any red line or in any wetland.
3. Cut tops must be used as a travel mat for equipment to prevent rutting as well as to expose a suitable seedbed.
4. Landings and any new road locations must be approved prior to construction.
5. All dead standing trees must be left standing unless they pose a safety hazard to the harvesting operation.
