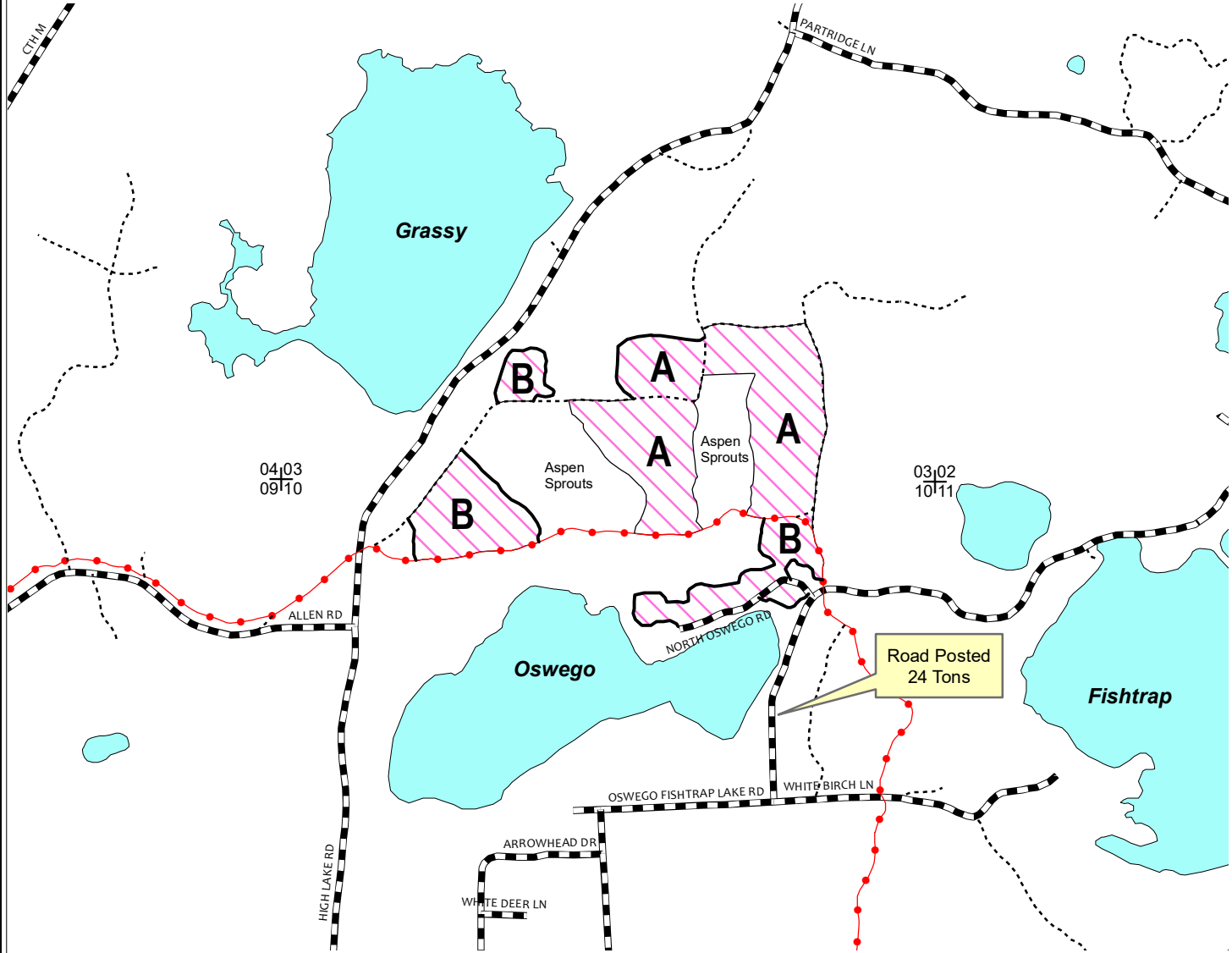



All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter chosen by the bidder will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree harvest is allowed on this timber sale.

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The following is based upon volumes to a 4" top:

1\ Balsam Fir – Approximately 401 tons Balsam Fir, 8 tons White Pine and 6 tons Red Pine. Weighted average = 2.126 tons/cord.

2\ Mixed Hardwood – Approximately 666 tons white birch, 369 tons red maple, 15 tons oak; included in this volume is approximately 25 MBF of white birch. Weighted average = 2.357 tons/cord.

3\ White Pine – Approximately 33 MBF White Pine and 22 MBF Red Pine.

Sale contains approximately 55.5 tons/acre or 25.2 cords/acre.

Special Conditions

- SEASONAL RESTRICTION:**
  - Zone A: Cutting permitted year round.
  - Zone B: No harvest activity between April 15 and July 15.
- All landings and any new roads must be approved prior to sale start up. All roads and the snowmobile trail must be cleared of debris and leveled upon sale completion.
- All pine products cut between May 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to May 1 of each year.
- Slash within 50 feet of the snowmobile trail and Town Road must be lopped and scattered within 2 feet of the ground and pulled back into the sale area at least 10 feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.
- Do not operate machinery within 15 feet of any ephemeral pond or wetland.
