

# NH-ALSF TRACT NO. 3-21 Max Lake

### Vilas County

#### Town 41 North, Range 6 East

Section 23 – NWNE, SWNE, SENE, NENW, SWNW, SENW, GL 1, NWSE, SWSE, GL 2

15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 95 acres.

The contract period is 3 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter will be cut and utilized. Whole Tree harvest is not allowed.

## **Special Conditions:**

- 1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees.
- 2. Trees may not be felled into wetland/swamp areas.
- 3. No harvesting, skidding or road construction from April 15<sup>th</sup> to July 15<sup>th</sup> due to the risk of oak wilt.
- 4. Trucking on Shucha Road should be avoided.
- 5. Snowmobile trails must be kept free of debris and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times.
- 6. The snowmobile trail aka "Camp Lake Road" must be repaired to pre-harvest conditions.
- 7. Note: The main access road to the north end of the timber sale has issues with periodic flooding. A reroute is planned to be constructed by the State by the end of 2021. Logging operations before that time may be interrupted.

<sup>1</sup> Balsam Fir consists of 73% balsam fir, 22% white pine and 5% red pine. Wt. Avg. is 2.126 tons/cord.

<sup>2</sup> Mixed Hardwood consists of 60% red maple, 32% hard maple and 8% white birch. Wt. Avg. is 2.372 tons/cord.
