



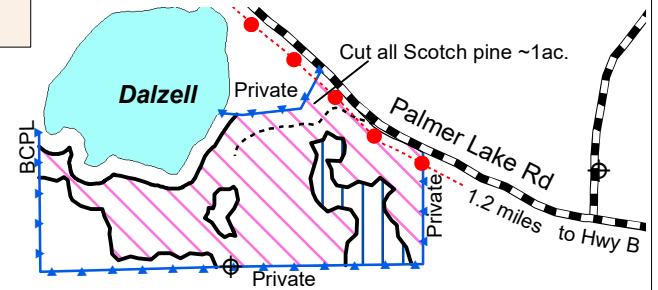

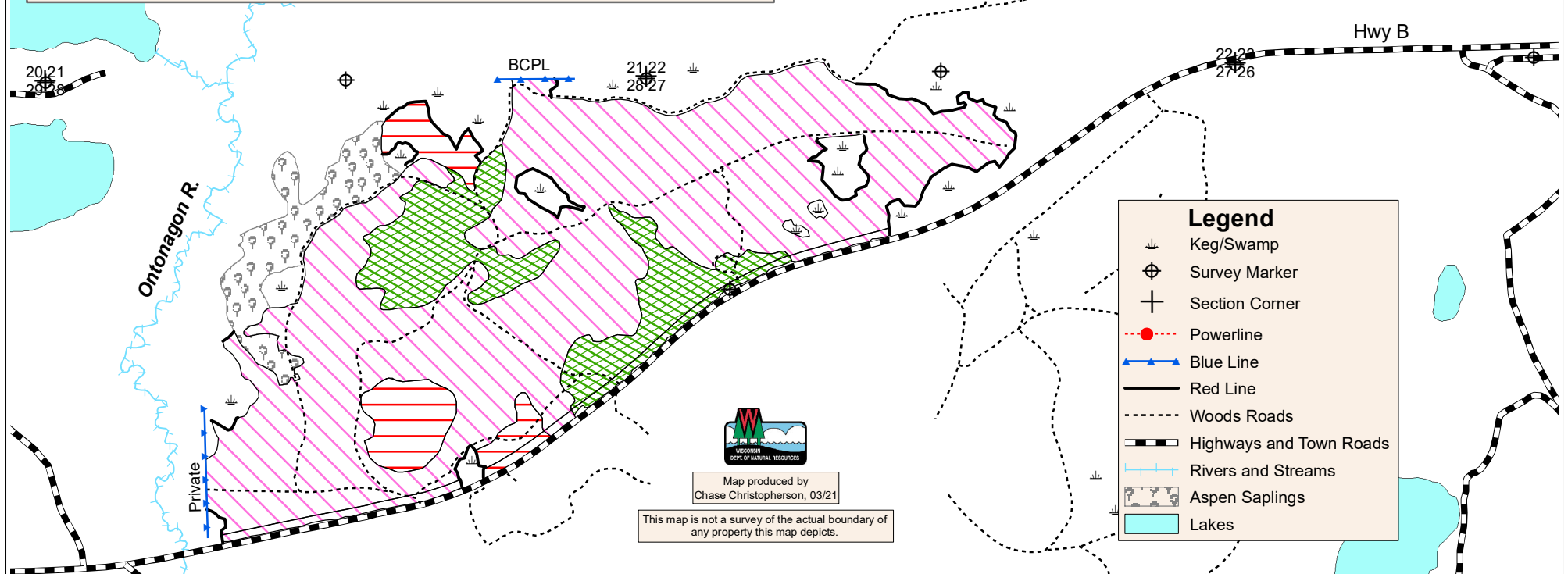
-  Hemlock (24 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, spruce and orange marked trees.
-  Swamp Hardwoods (6 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, spruce, white birch and orange marked trees. Harvesting limited to very dry or frozen ground only.
-  Northern Hardwoods (283 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, spruce, white birch and orange marked trees.
-  Spruce (49 Acres): Cut all aspen, balsam fir, spruce, white birch, and orange marked trees.


**Note: Do NOT cut trees marked with green paint.
Do NOT operate equipment within 15 feet of any wetland
unless the ground is firm or frozen.**

Forest Production Mgmt Area












15% of the total sale bid value will be required for performance bond.

The cutting area is approximately 362 acres.

The contract period is 3 years.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Whole Tree harvest is not allowed.

1 Balsam fir consists of 52% white spruce, 46% balsam fir and 2% Scotch pine. (wt. conv. 2.070 tons/cord)

2 Mixed Hardwood pulp consists of 87% hard maple, 8% red maple, 3% white birch, 1% basswood, 1% yellow birch and <1% ash. (wt. conv. 2.516 tons/cord)

3 Mixed Hardwood logs consists of 69% hard maple, 13% white birch, 10% ash, 4% basswood, 2% yellow birch and 1% red maple.

Note: Total sale volume equates to 32.1 tons/acre or 13.6 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees.
2. Pole skidding WILL NOT be allowed within the marked area.
3. Slash within 50 feet of highways and town roads must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and pulled back at least ten feet behind tree line concurrently with cutting.
4. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at this time can decide to remedy them before pulling off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
