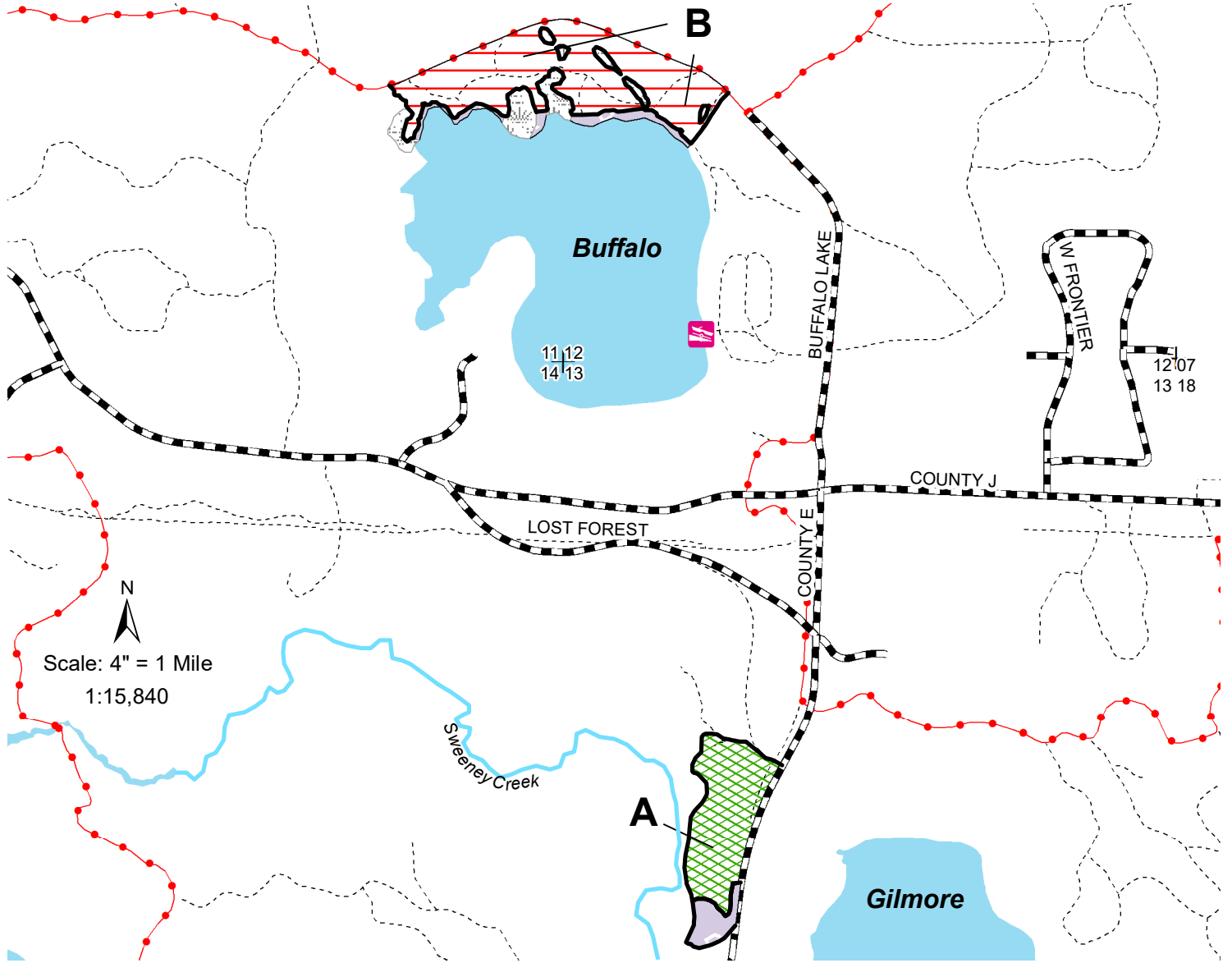

- Mixed Pine and Aspen Area (33 Acres): Cut all merchantable aspen, maple, birch, and balsam fir. Cut all trees marked with orange paint.
- Pine Area (16 Acres): Cut all merchantable aspen, maple, and balsam fir. Cut all trees marked with orange paint.
- Green Tree Retention Area (GTR): Do not harvest any trees in these areas.

- A** Harvesting in Zone A is allowed from July 31st to January 14th.
- B** Harvesting in Zone B is allowed from July 16th to April 14th.

Buffalo Rodeo

The total sale area is approximately 55 acres which includes 6 acres of Green Tree Retention (GTR). All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized. Biomass harvesting is not permitted on this sale.

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<sup>1</sup> Approximately 60% white pine and 40% red pine. Includes potential for 18 MBF white pine sawlogs and 3 MBF red pine sawlogs.

<sup>2</sup> Approximately 80% red maple, 15% white birch, and 5 % red oak. Includes potential for 3 MBF red oak sawlogs and 3 MBF red maple sawlogs.

Note: Total sale volume equates to 23.5 tons/acre or 10.4 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. **Harvesting activities including cutting, skidding and road building are authorized between July 16<sup>th</sup> and April 14<sup>th</sup> due to Oak Wilt concerns.**
2. **Harvesting activities including cutting, skidding and road building in Stand A are permitted between July 31<sup>st</sup> and January 14<sup>th</sup>.**
3. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
4. Cutting must be concurrent for all species.
5. Leave all dead trees unless they pose a safety hazard.
6. Slash within 50 feet of all roads and trails must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and be pulled back 10 feet behind the tree line concurrently with cutting. The snowmobile trail must be kept free of debris, snow covered in winter and always left in good condition for vehicle traffic. The trail must be repaired to pre-harvest condition prior to each snow season.

**Notice:** Completion of this form is mandatory. The Department will not recognize your bid unless you complete and submit this form. In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
