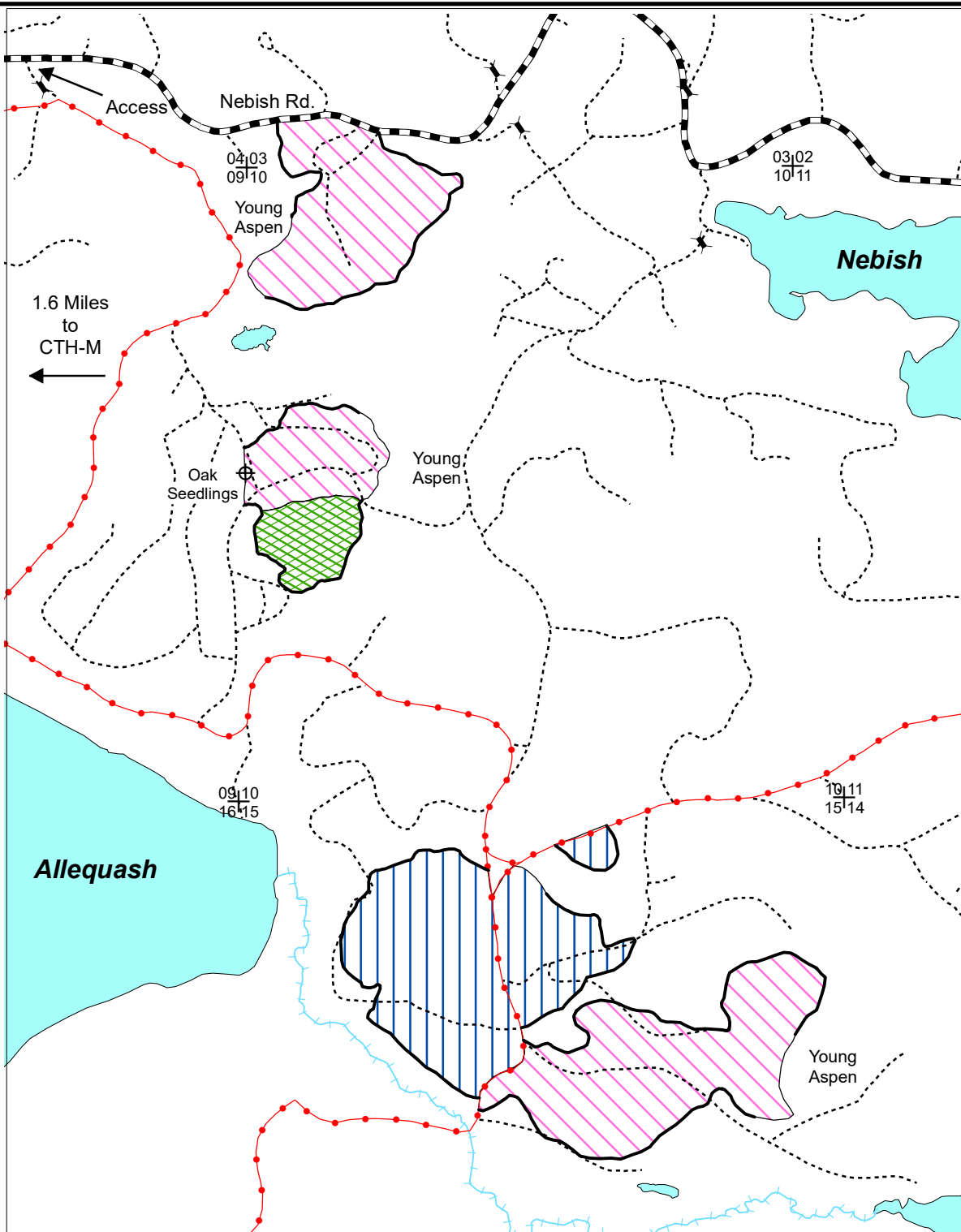


**WISCONSIN

T41N R7E SECTIONS 3, 10, 15
HARVEST ACRES - 200**



Overstory Removal (71 Acres): Cut all oak, aspen red maple, hard maple, balsam fir, and white birch greater than 4" and **not** marked green. Cut all orange marked red and white pine.

Red Pine Thinning (12 Acres): Cut all orange marked trees.

Oak Thinning (117 Acres): Cut all orange marked trees.

Note: Harvesting, skidding and road construction allowed July 16th - April 14th.

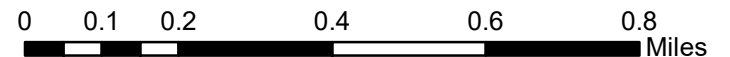

Nebiquash

The cutting area is approximately 200 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree utilization is not allowed.

1 Approximately 73% red maple, 24% hard maple, 2% white birch and 1% aspen. Includes approximately 9 MBF red maple and 12 MBF hard maple sawlogs.

2. Includes 114 MBF of sawlogs.

3. Approximately 75% red pine and 25% white pine. Includes approximately 42 MBF of sawlogs.

Sale contains approximately 31 tons/acre or approximately 13 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. **Seasonal Restriction:** Harvesting, skidding and road construction will only be allowed from July 16th to April 14th due risk of oak wilt.
2. The snowmobile trail must be kept free of debris, snow covered in winter and always left in good condition for vehicle traffic. The trail must be repaired to pre-harvest condition prior to each snow season. Slash within 50 feet of the snowmobile trail and Nebish Rd must be lopped and scattered to within two feet of the ground and pulled back into the sale area at least 10 feet.
3. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
4. All landings and any new roads must be approved prior to sale start up. All woods roads must be cleared of debris and leveled upon completion of sale.
5. Do not harvest trees or operate equipment with 15 feet of any ephemeral pond. No slash or logging debris shall be deposited within ephemeral ponds.
6. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from the time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
7. Felling and skidding damage to residual trees must be avoided. Do not knock down or utilize any dead trees unless they pose a safety hazard.
8. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at this time can decide to remedy them before pulling off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.

Notice: Completion of this form is mandatory. The Department will not recognize your bid unless you complete and submit this form. Personal information collected will be used for program administration and may be provided to requesters as required by Wisconsin's Public Records law [ss. 19.31-19.39, Wis. Stats.].

In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
