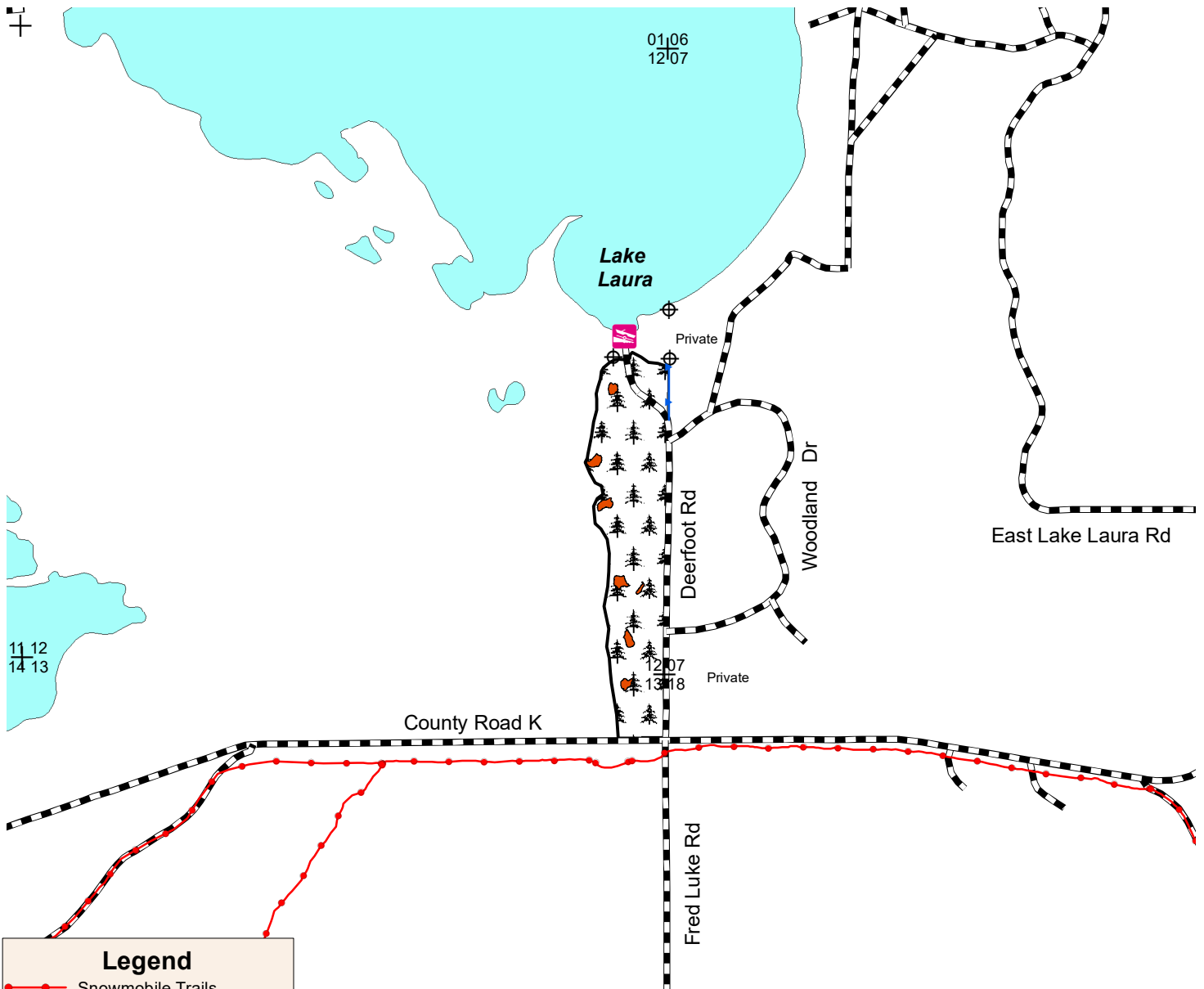

Deerfoot

The cutting area is approximately 38 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to a 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

³Volume includes approximately 10 MBF of basswood.

Total sale volume equates to 23.4 tons/acre or 10.2 cords/acre.

Special Conditions:

1. Harvesting, skidding, hauling, and road construction is allowed from September 30th to March 20th.
2. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees (except balsam fir).
3. Slash within 50 feet of all roads and trails must be lopped and/or scattered to lie within two feet of the ground and be pulled back 10' behind the tree line concurrently with cutting.
4. Whole tree utilization or biomass harvesting is not allowed.
5. Follow WI BMPs for water quality at all times.
6. Cutting must be concurrent for all species.
7. All landings must be approved prior to sale start up. No loading on Deerfoot Rd. All existing roads must remain clear of slash.
8. Do not cut any trees marked with red or blue paint.
9. Purple marked trees will be cut or pushed over and left whole.
