

NH-ALSF TRACT NO. 15-25 Dead Ice

The cutting area is approximately 107 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to the minimum top diameter will be cut and utilized. Whole Tree harvest is not allowed.

1 MX consists of approximately 86% hard maple, 8% red maple and 6% ash. Included is an estimated 51 MBF hard maple, 3 MBF red maple and 10 MBF ash.

Special Conditions:

- 1. <u>Access options</u>: The main state forest haul route is highlighted on the map. This route will need a small amount of road work. There is also an option of constructing approximately 600 feet of new road to shorten the haul distance to County Highway B. For access to the east across private land, it will be the responsibility of the contractor to get permission from the landowner. Access to the north has been granted through BCPL lands for decking and hauling.
- 2. The woods road to the private land on Palmer Lake shall be kept free of debris and left in good condition for vehicle traffic at all times.
- 3. Seasonal Restrictions: Harvesting is allowed July 31 to Spring breakup. Permission may be granted to move in earlier with DNR Forester approval.
- 4. Pole skidding WILL NOT be allowed within the marked area.
- 5. Do not operate within 15 feet of a wetland unless the ground is firm or frozen.
- 6. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees
- 7. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One-week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at this time can decide to remedy them before pulling off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
