

Northern Hardwood (83 Acres): Cut all fir, white birch and orange marked trees.

Harvesting allowed in Northern Hardwood stand July 16 - April 14.

Aspen (105 Acres): Cut all aspen, fir, maple, white birch, spruce and orange marked trees. Cut all maple 1-5" in diameter.

Do NOT cut trees marked with green paint. Do NOT cut 1-5 inch maple within 20 feet of any improved road's edge.

# NH-ALSF TRACT NO. 19-25 Ristow's Refuge

The cutting area is approximately 188 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to a minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized. Whole tree harvesting is NOT allowed.

# Total Minimum Bid Value \$130,800.00

- 1\ Volume includes approximately 98% balsam fir, and less than 2% white pine, red pine and white spruce.
- 2\ Contains approximately 133 MBF oak.
- 3\ Volume includes approximately 48% white birch, 29% sugar maple and 23% red maple. Includes approximately 57 MBF of potential white birch logs, 42 MBF sugar maple logs and 47 MBF red maple sawlogs.
- 4\ Volume includes approximately 35 MBF white pine, 20 MBF red pine and 10 MBF white spruce.

Sale contains approximately 46 tons/acre or 20 cords/acre.

### **Special Conditions**

- SEASONAL RESTRICTION: Harvest activity in the Northern Hardwood Area is allowed only between July 16 and April
- 2. Do not cut 1-5 inch maple within 20 feet of the Hunter Access Trail or any improved logging roads.
- 3. All landings and any new roads must be approved prior to sale start up. All roads must be cleared of debris and leveled upon sale completion.
- 4. Do not harvest any trees or operate machinery within 15 feet of any vernal pond. Do not deposit any slash or tops in them. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
- 5. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
- 6. Biomass harvesting is not allowed. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees unless they pose an operational safety risk. Do not cut any trees marked with green paint.
- 7. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.
