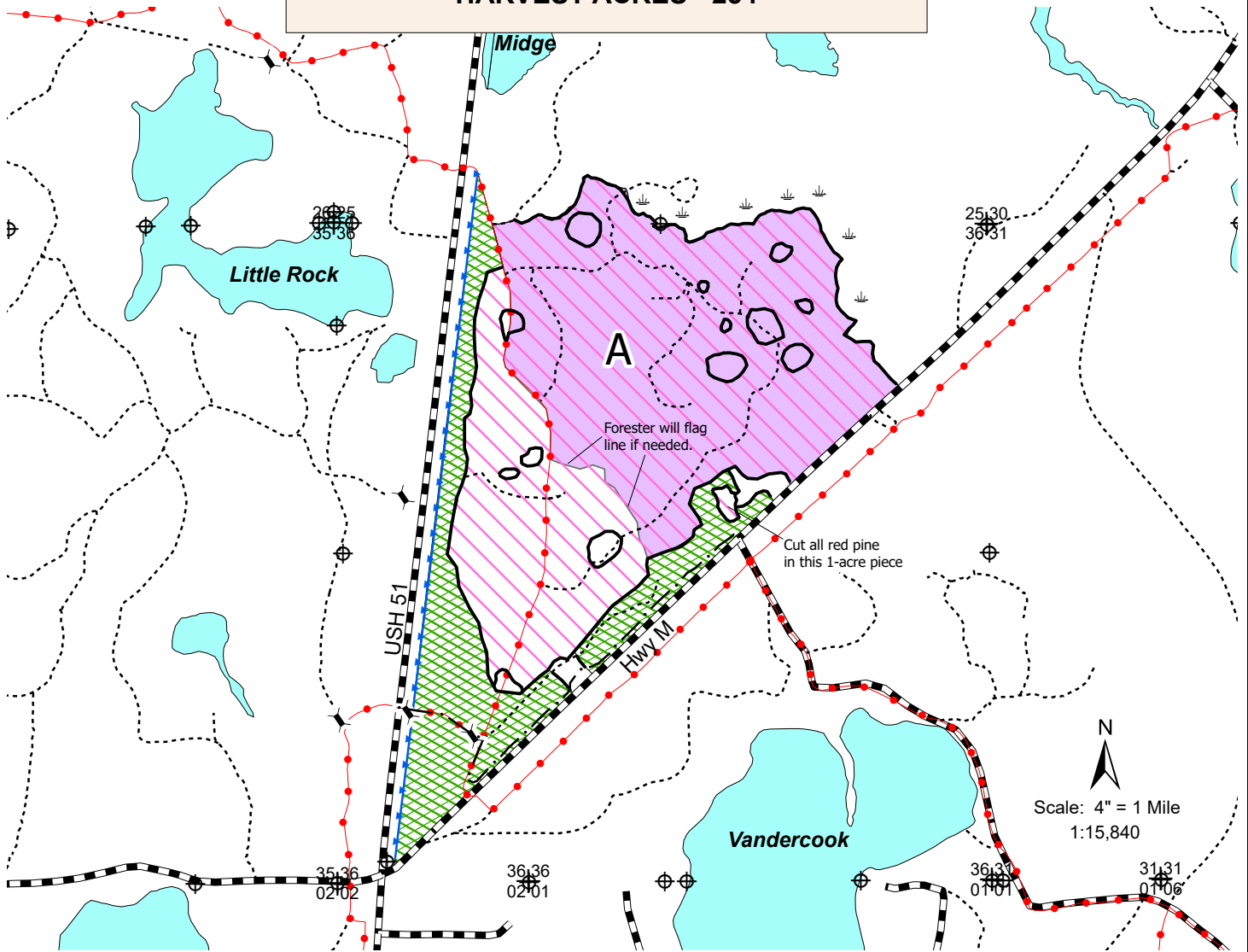

Pine / Oak Area (58 Acres): Cut all aspen, fir and orange marked trees.

Aspen / Pine Area (196 Acres): Cut all aspen and fir. Cut all 1" - 8" maple and orange marked pine.

***Zone A has no seasonal restrictions.
Harvesting allowed July 16 - April 14 in the
rest of sale area.***

Do not cut any trees marked with green paint.

Stupendous Pines

The cutting area is approximately 254 acres.

All trees that will yield one or more 100-inch sticks to a minimum 4" top diameter will be cut and utilized.

Whole tree harvesting is NOT allowed.

Special Conditions

1. SEASONAL RESTRICTION: Zone A has no seasonal restrictions. Harvesting allowed July 16 – April 14 in the rest of the sale area. The Forester administering the sale will flag the line separating the two seasonal harvest areas east of the snowmobile trail if needed.
2. Do not cut any maple within 20 feet of the ATV/UTV/Snowmobile trail or any improved roads.
3. All landings and any new roads must be approved prior to sale start up. All roads must be cleared of debris and leveled upon sale completion.
4. Do not harvest any trees or operate machinery within 15 feet of any vernal pond. Do not deposit any slash or tops in them. Cutting must be concurrent for all species to be harvested.
5. All pine products cut between April 1 and September 1 must be removed from the sale area within three weeks from time of cutting. Pine products cut during the remainder of the year must be removed prior to April 1 of each year.
6. Biomass harvesting is not allowed. Do not cut, knock down or utilize any dead trees unless they pose an operational safety risk. Do not cut any trees marked with green paint.
7. If the contract is to be worked on during multiple time periods a mid-contract "pull-off" inspection meeting will be required. One week notice shall be given by the contractor prior to moving equipment off-site. During the "pull-off" inspection, provisions needing attention will be documented. The contractor at that time can decide to remedy them before pulling equipment off or rectify them when moving back onto the site. If the latter is chosen, documented items shall be addressed before harvesting can continue.

In the event the highest bidder can not or will not sign the contract, the award may be made to the next highest qualified bid.
