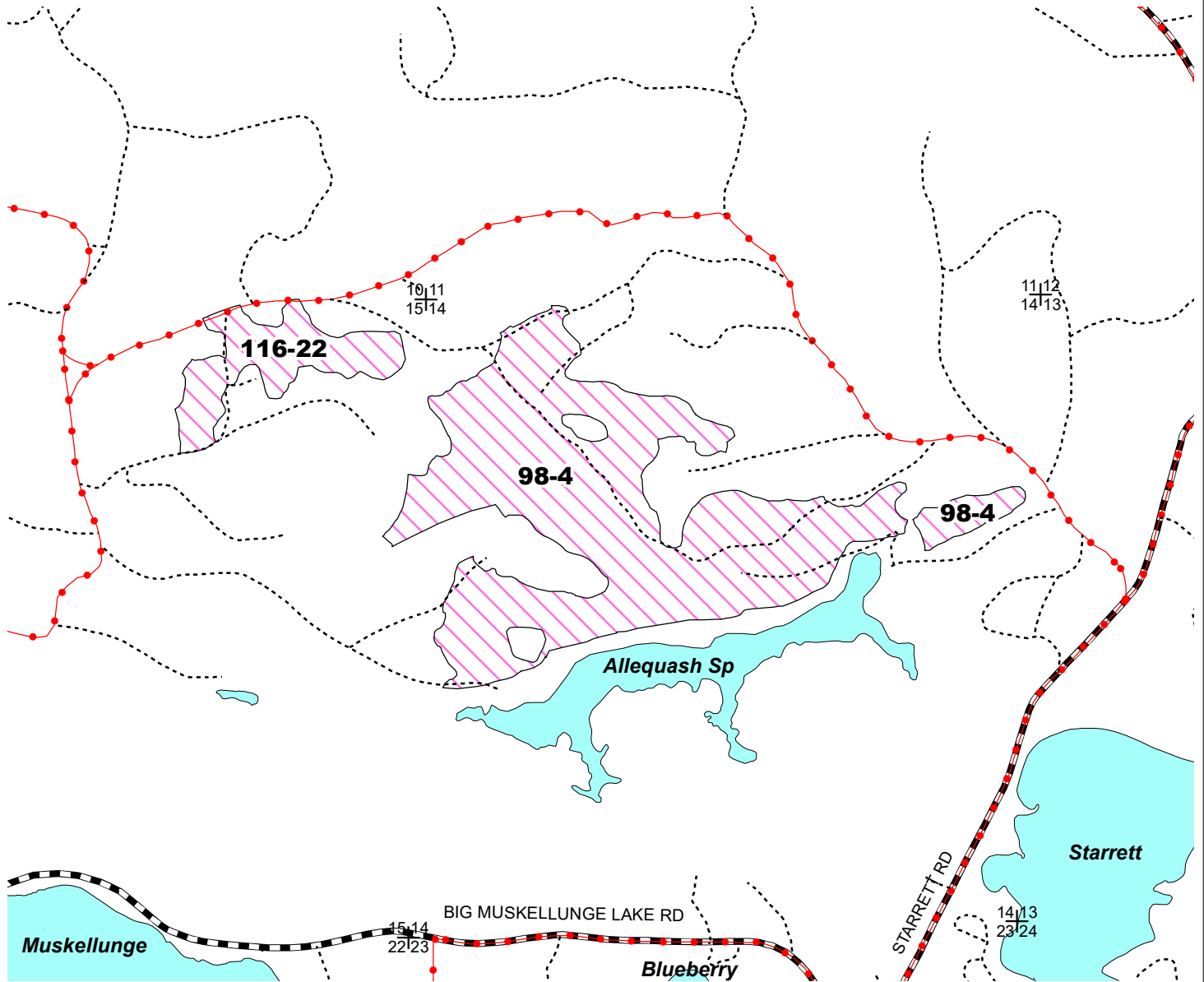

C98H – Stand 4 & C116H – Stand 22 (154 acres): These two stands are the same, just in different compartments. They are comprised of 104-year old large sawlog red oak, averaging 21 square feet of BA per acre. The stands will undergo an overstory removal, leaving a minimum of 5 to 10 residual trees per acre after the sale. The advanced regeneration red oak seedlings are doing very well and should be released sufficiently to regenerate the stand.

It is feasible that a prescribed burn may be conducted to further aid the establishment of the red oak seedlings.

A snowmobile runs through the sale area, but given how remote this area is it is not likely to be harvested in the winter.
