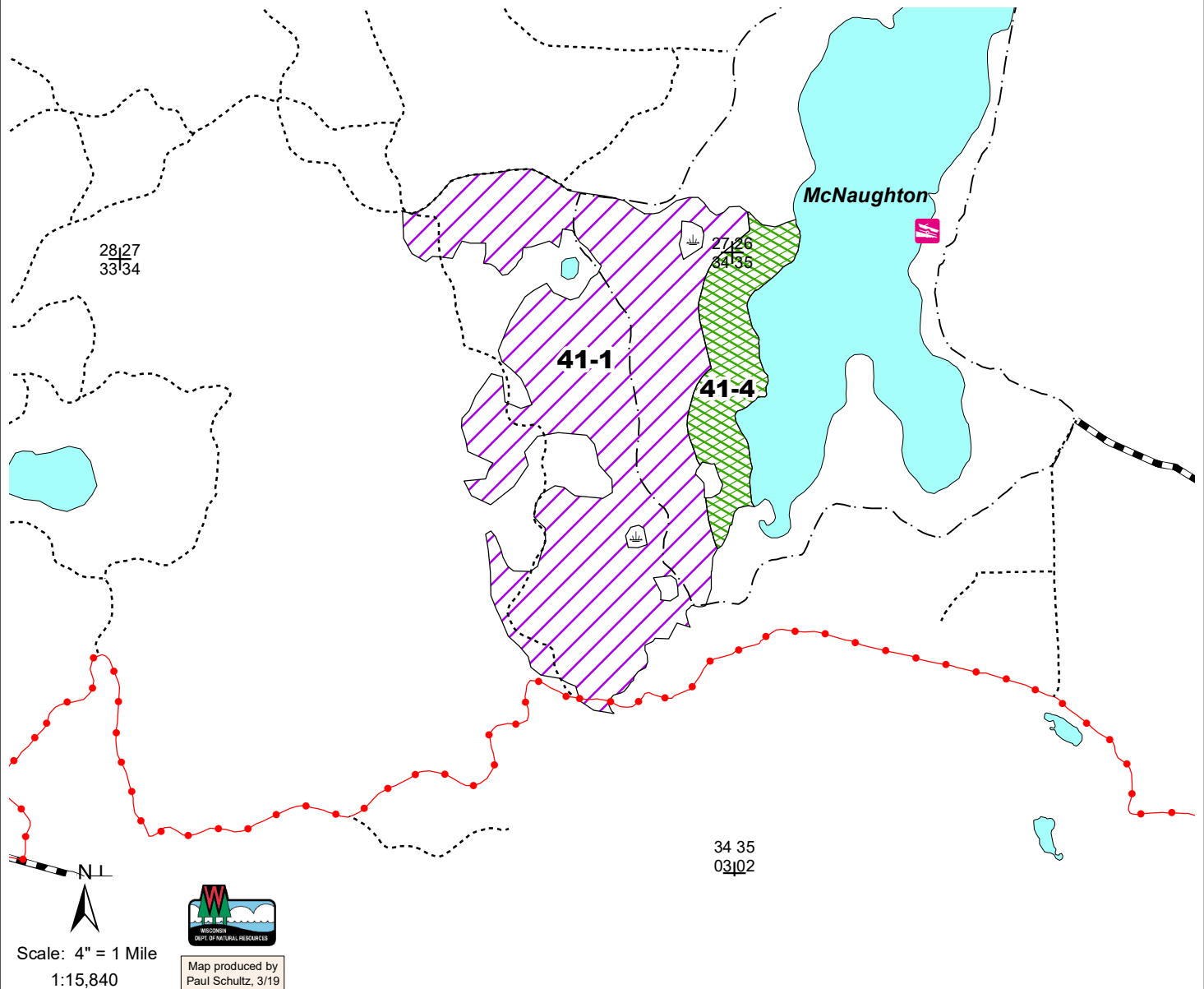
C41A Stands 1 & 4

Stand 41-1 (150 acres) is a 47-year old stand of aspen. The management objective for this stand is to regenerate the aspen and add to the age-class diversity of this type in the area. This will be accomplished by removing most of the trees, while following green tree retention guidelines. Aesthetic considerations will be taken into account along the McNaughton recreational trail.

Stand 41-4 (26 acres) is a mixed stand of aspen, hemlock and scattered associated species. The goal is to maintain and enhance the aesthetic qualities in this Scenic Lake zone. This will be accomplished mainly by marking individual high-risk trees and removing some short-lived species as well. Hemlock will be maintained.

Biomass harvesting is allowed.
