

**Stand 5 (24 acres)** is in the County Highway K Rustic Road zone. Objectives are to favor longer-lived species of red and white pine or other long-lived tree species. Thinning the stand will promote forest health and benefit pine growth.

**Stand 6 (13 acres)** is an oak stand of 1921 origin. Last harvested in 1998. The stand will receive a shelterwood harvest to regenerate oak.

**Stand 25 (7 acres)** is a tamarack and black spruce stand. The stand will be regenerated using the seed-tree method. Frozen ground harvesting only.

**Stand 28 (11 acres)** is a red pine plantation established in 1938. The stand was last harvested around 1980. The pine will be thinned and the pockets of mature aspen will be harvested.
