
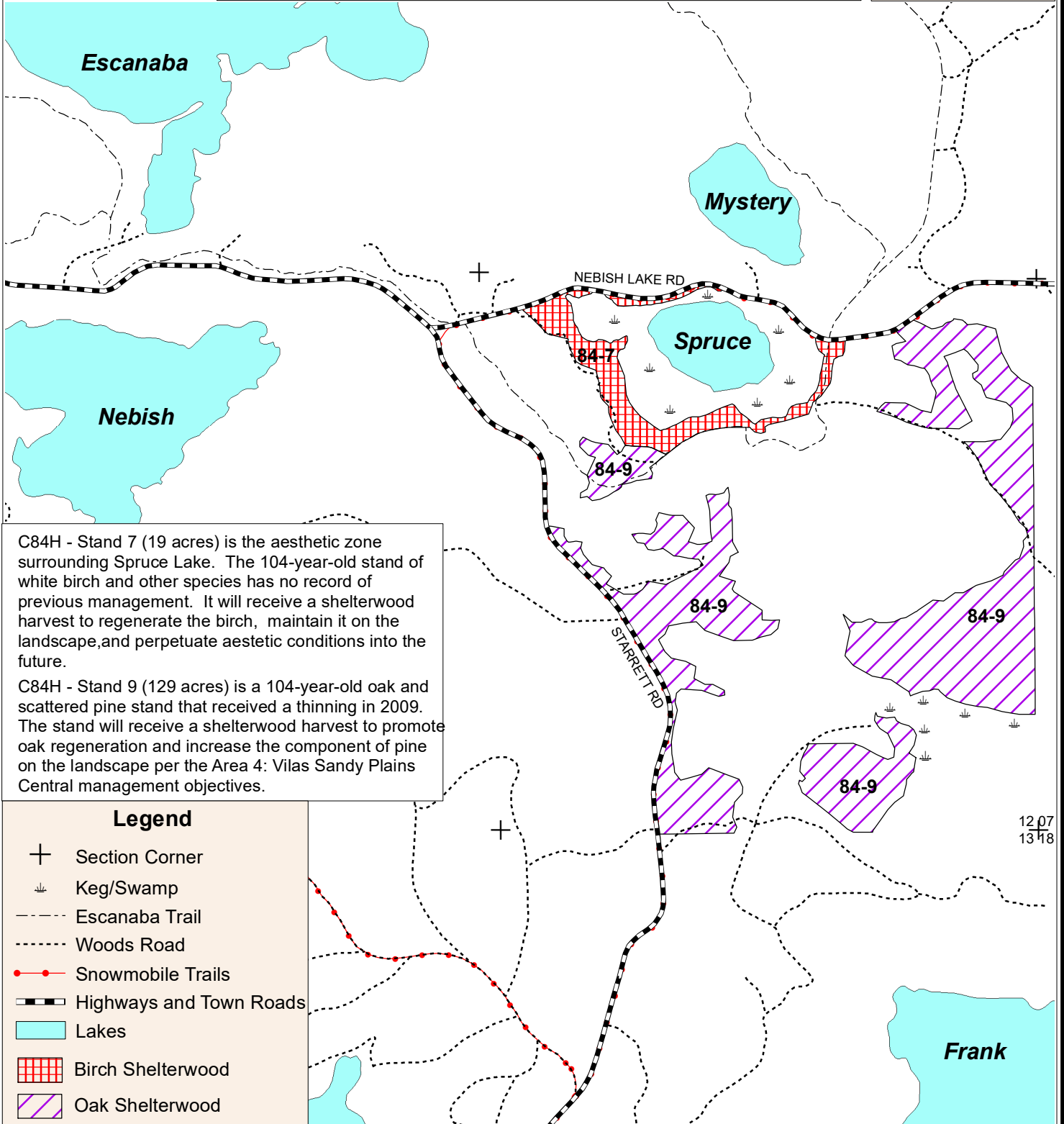

C84H - Stand 7 (19 acres) is the aesthetic zone surrounding Spruce Lake. The 104-year-old stand of white birch and other species has no record of previous management. It will receive a shelterwood harvest to regenerate the birch, maintain it on the landscape, and perpetuate aesthetic conditions into the future.

C84H - Stand 9 (129 acres) is a 104-year-old oak and scattered pine stand that received a thinning in 2009. The stand will receive a shelterwood harvest to promote oak regeneration and increase the component of pine on the landscape per the Area 4: Vilas Sandy Plains Central management objectives.
