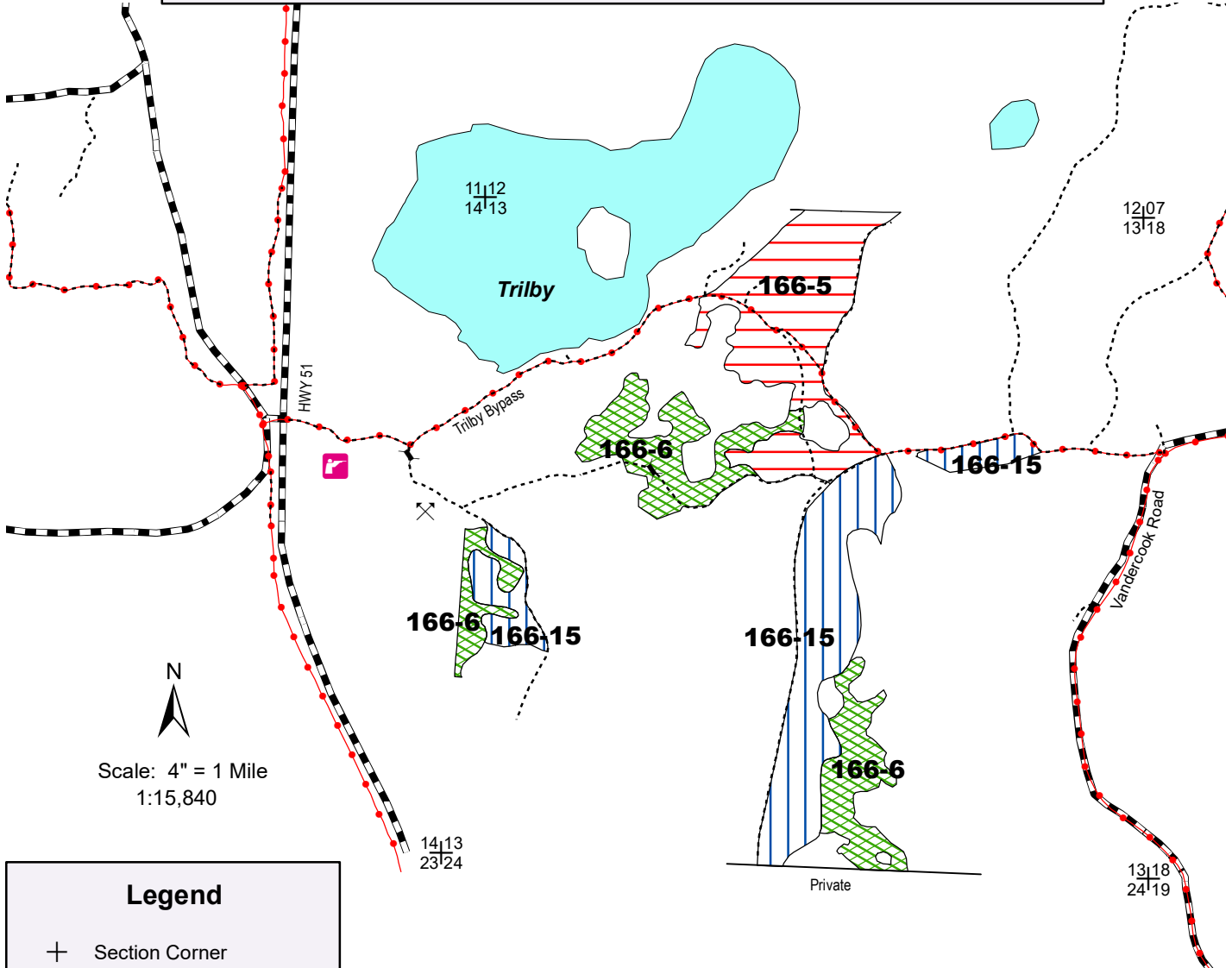


Northern Highland - American Legion State Forest

Stand 5 (36 Acres) is comprised of a good stocking of northern hardwood and oak. This stand was last thinned in 2000. This stand will be selectively marked to favor and release the best quality oak and hardwood crop trees.

Stand 6 (34 Acres) is a 105 year old well stocked white pine sawtimber stand that is ready for an improvement thinning. This stand will be marked following the standard order of removal to reduce stocking levels and promote the growth and vigor of the remaining crop trees.

Stand 15 (44 Acres) is comprised of 51 year old well stocked aspen poletimber with associated white birch, red maple, balsam fir and oak poletimber. Some red and white pine sawtimber clumps are also scattered within the stand. The goal is to maintain aspen as a strong component across the landscape. The stand will be regenerated using a coppice with standards forest management prescription.

There is a good network of roads in the area with access to Hwy 51.
