
Willow Flowage Scenic Waters Area Compartment 22 Stands 1, 19, & 21 Peaceful Pines - 64 acres

Willow Flowage Master Plan: Area 1 - Forested Backlands Forest Production &




<u>Legend</u>

Stand 1 (37 acres) - is a 1962 origin red pine plantation last thinned in 2010. The stand will be thinned again to improve stand quality, health and vigor. Red pine pocket decline areas will be salvaged including healthy trees adjoining the declining trees to prevent future losses. Aesthetics will be prioritized within the Scenic Management Area portions.

Stand 19 (10 acres) - is a 1990 origin red pine plantation ready for a first thinning. Approximately ever third row will be harvested to improve stand health and vigor and to create access for future thinnings.

Stand 21 (17 acres) - is a mixed white pine stand of approximately 1924 origin. This stand is mostly within the Scenic Management Area and will be thinned to favor longer lived species. Planting may also occur post harvest to promote longer lived species. Some site preparation work may be needed prior to planting.
