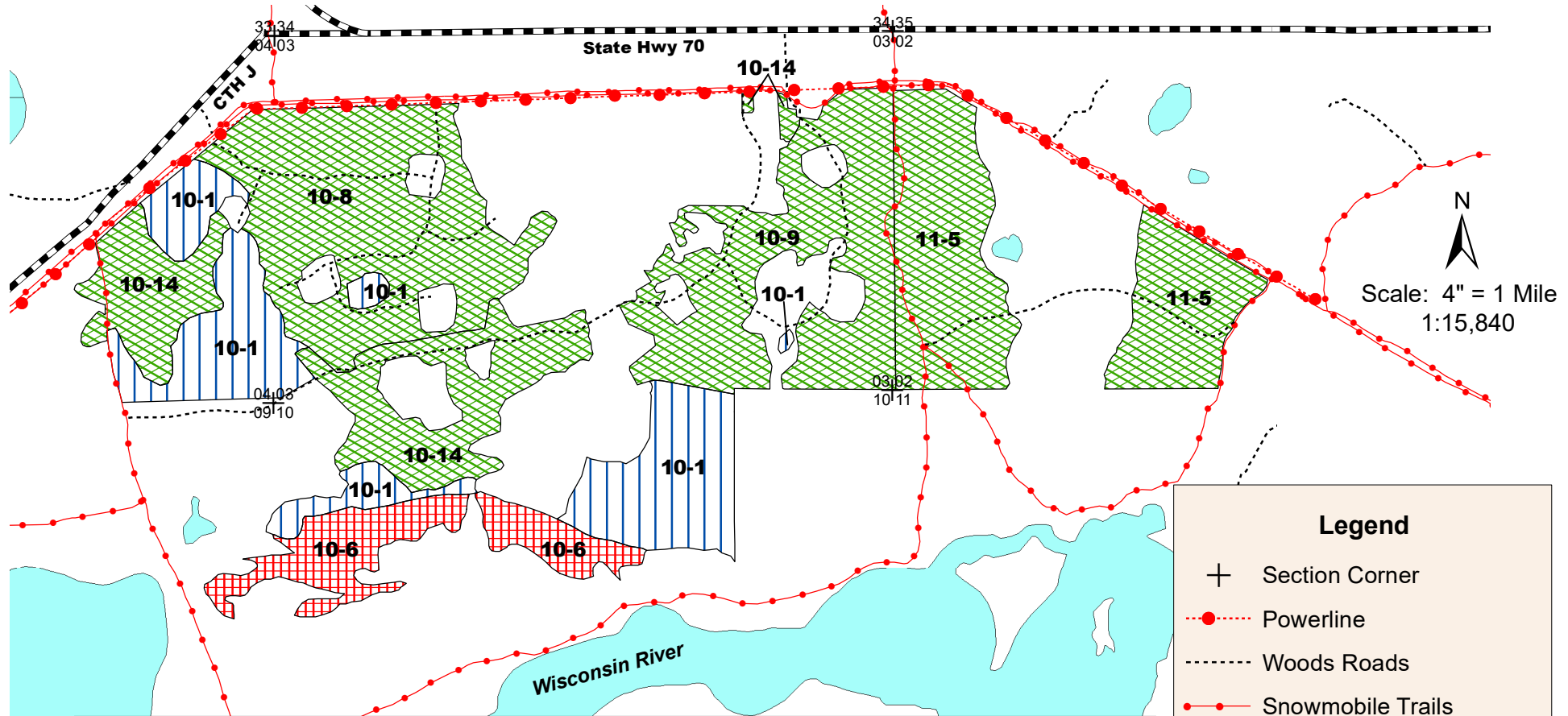


Northern Highland - American Legion State Forest

C10A - Stand 1 (81 Acres) is comprised of 48 year old well stocked aspen poletimber with other associated species. The goal is to maintain aspen as a strong component across the landscape. A coppice with standards harvest will be prescribed to regenerate this stand.

C10A - Stand 6 (32 Acres) is comprised of 117 year old variable stocked black spruce poletimber. The prescription for this stand will be to harvest and regenerate the outer merchantable edges.

C10A - Stands 8, 9 & 14 & C11A - Stand 5 (300 Acres) are comprised of well stocked red pine poletimber and sawtimber plantations. Stand ages range from 43-65 years old. These stands were all thinned in the past and are all now well stocked. The prescription for all these stands will be an improvement thinning following the standard order of removal to reduce stocking levels and promote the growth and vigor of remaining crop trees.

There is a good network of woods roads and a snowmobile trail that traverse the area.

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
