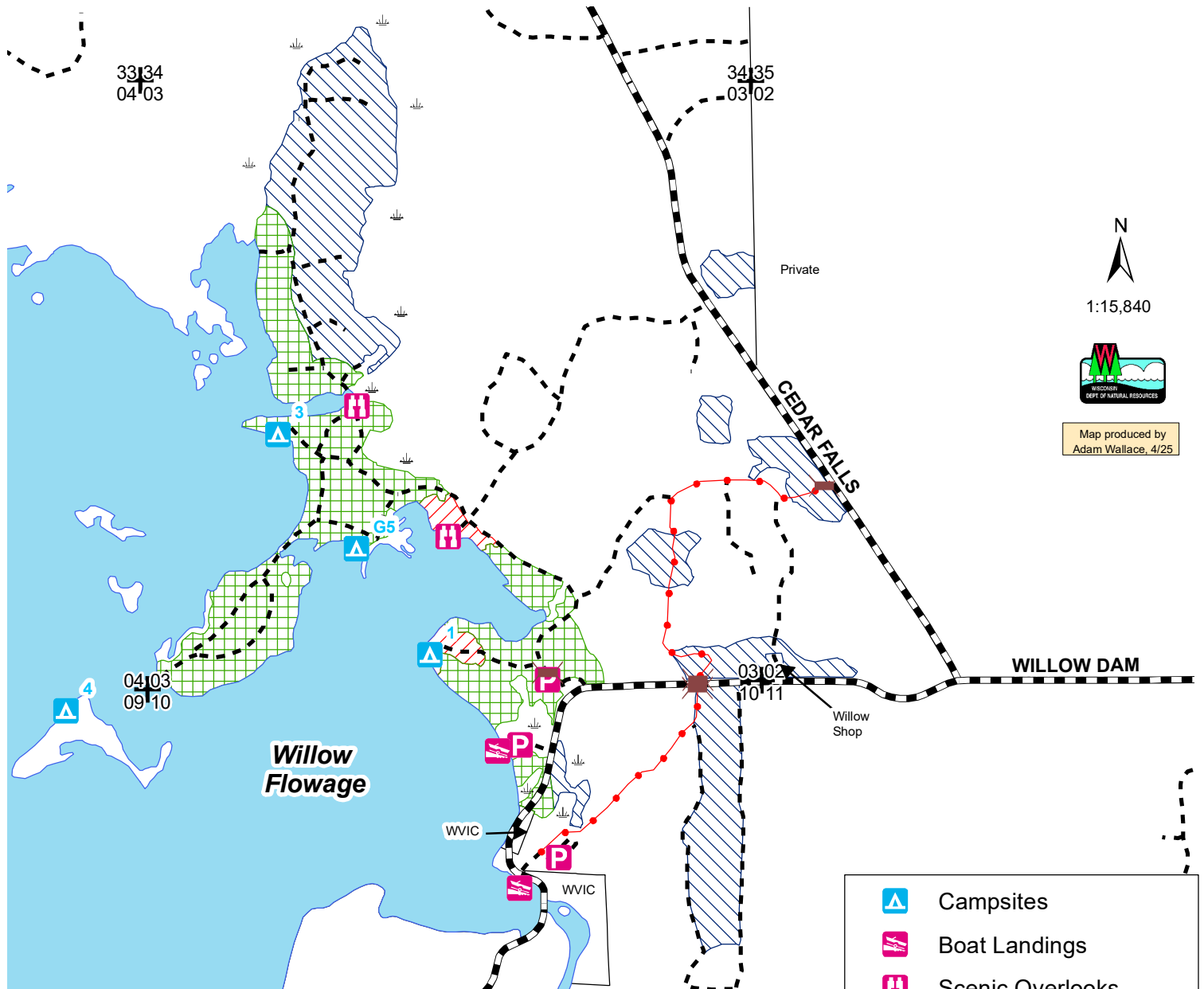

-  Stand 5 (82 acres) - is 1962 origin aspen within the Willow Flowage Scenic Management Area. This stand will be thinned for aesthetics and to encourage longer-lived species. White pine may be underplanted following the harvest and some site preparation may be required.
-  Stand 20 (96 acres) - is 1962 origin aspen that will be regenerated via a coppice cut with standards. White/red pine, oak, and spruce will generally remain and will be thinned where needed.
-  Stand 21 (6 acres) - is 1930 origin natural red pine that will be thinned to increase stand health and vigor and to maintain aesthetics within the Scenic Mgmt Area.
