




TREE CANOPY

Many communities aspire to expand tree canopy because of the wide array of services trees offer. Knowing your canopy cover sets a baseline of knowledge to help promote your forest and set canopy goals.

Tree canopy maps also enable identification of underserved areas and areas of potential growth. They help prioritize where communities should focus tree planting activities in the future.

ECO-BENEFITS

Trees are part of a community's infrastructure, providing valuable benefits:

- Stormwater reduction**
Prevent rain from burdening infrastructure
- Natural gas savings**
Block wind, reducing winter heating costs
- Property value**
Add real estate value
- Energy savings**
Cool buildings, reducing air conditioning costs

- **Prioritize tree planting locations**
- **Set tree canopy goals**
 - Establish your area of interest
 - Identify current tree canopy
 - Assess goal criteria
 - Compare canopy cover
 - Identify where canopy can be expanded
 - Consider budget, staff and time
- **Adopt goals based on assessments**
 - Protect and maintain existing trees
 - Plant new trees
 - Promote public awareness
