

NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF A FEASIBILITY AND PLAN OF OPERATION REPORT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to section NR 670.432(2), Wisconsin Administrative Code, that the Department of Natural Resources (Department), on July 18, 2022, received an application from Hydrite Chemical Co. to renew its hazardous waste management facility operating license for up to an additional 10 years. Hydrite's facility is located at 114 N. Main Street, Cottage Grove, WI in Dane County.

The facility is currently licensed for hazardous waste storage in containers (#6006), storage in tanks (#3200), and treatment in tanks (#4437). The application seeks to renew each of these licenses. The application includes a Feasibility and Plan of Operation Report (FPOR) that describes the licensed units and proposed continued operations. The purpose of the review of the application and FPOR is to determine whether the facility is still feasible for use as a hazardous waste facility and to develop site-specific license conditions for continued operation of this hazardous waste facility. The Department is currently performing the completeness review and environmental review under ss. 289.24 and 289.25, Wis. Stats., and will provide additional notice when it has completed this review and developed a preliminary determination.
