NOTICE OF FEASIBILITY REPORT AND
PRELIMINARY ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT DECISIONS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to sections 289.24 and 289.25, Wis. Stats., that the Department of Natural Resources (department) has determined that the feasibility report submitted by the Adams County Solid Waste Department for the proposed Adams County Sanitary Landfill Vertical Expansion is complete and the department has made a preliminary determination that an environmental impact statement is not required. The proposed solid waste disposal facility is located in the S ½ of the NE ¼ of section 13, T18N, R5E, Town of Strong Prairie, Adams County, Wisconsin on land presently owned by the Adams County Solid Waste Department.

The proposed landfill expansion would consist of an 8.3-acre vertical expansion that would be located completely within waste limits previously approved by the department. The proposed landfill expansion, including the existing active municipal solid waste (MSW) landfill, would continue to occupy 21.9-acres of the approximately 581-acre property owned by Adams County. The proposed vertical expansion has a footprint of 8.3-acres, but this would not change the current total permitted footprint of 21.9-acres. The approved height of the landfill would increase approximately 42.5 feet from the currently approved height to a peak elevation of approximately 1,073.5 feet above mean sea level (ft-MSL). The proposed landfill expansion would provide approximately 247,500 cubic yards of additional capacity for a total landfill capacity of 1,495,500 cubic yards.

A solid waste landfill feasibility determination is an integrated analysis action under s. NR 150.20 (2) (a) 7, Wis. Adm. Code. The department has completed an environmental analysis for the proposed expansion and has made a preliminary determination that an environmental impact statement is not needed under section 1.11, Wis. Stats. Pursuant to sections 289.25(3) and 1.11, Wis. Stats., written comments by any person concerning the proposed solid waste disposal facility and the environmental analysis are invited.

All written comments must be received by the department within 30 days after the date of posting this notice on the department's internet website at <http://dnr.wisconsin.gov/topic/Waste/Comment.html> to Drae Rogers, Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, 2984 Shawano Ave, Green Bay, Wisconsin 54313, or drae.rogers@wisconsin.gov by e-mail.

A public hearing concerning the feasibility report may be requested in writing by any county, village, city or town, the applicant, or any 6 or more persons. The request shall indicate the interests of the municipality or persons who file the request and state the reasons why the hearing was requested. The hearing shall be conducted as an informational hearing utilizing the procedures in s. NR 2.135, Wis. Adm. Code unless the request filed indicates pursuant to section 289.27(1), Wis. Stats., that the hearing is to be treated as a contested case, as provided under section 227.42, Wis. Stats., and that:

1. A substantial interest of the person requesting the treatment of the hearing as contested case is injured in fact or threatened with injury by the Department's action or inaction on the matter;
2. The injury to the person requesting the treatment of the hearing as a contested case is different in kind or degree from injury to the general public caused by the Department's action or inaction on the matter; and
3. There is a dispute of material fact.

All hearing requests must be received by the department within 30 days after the posting date of this notice on the department's website, either by delivery to the Office of the Secretary of the Department at
