Effluent Quality and Plant Performance (Ammonia - NH₃)

1. Effluent Ammonia Results

1.1 Verify the following monthly and weekly average effluent values, exceedances, and points for Ammonia.

Check the effluent monthly and weekly average Ammonia (NH₃) concentrations to ensure they are correct. If the numbers disagree with your reported eDMR values, contact your DNR District Wastewater Engineer or Specialist by clicking the 'REPORT ISSUE' button or by phone.

Note: Ammonia data is only brought in when weekly or monthly limits are effective. No averages will be generated if only daily maximum limits are effective. If multiple limits are applicable (weekly and monthly), only monthly average data and applicable limits will be shown.

1.2 If any violations occurred, what action was taken to regain compliance?

If any permit limit exceedances are shown in 1.1, type an explanation in the box of action(s) taken to regain compliance.
