Water Quality Trading Plan – CONDITIONAL APPROVAL

Dear Mr. Nelson:

Thank you for submitting the recent amendment to WQT-2019-0016 for the Eleva Strum Joint Sewerage Commission. The final documentation was received on July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020. After review of the additional documentation and final report, the Department has no comments at this time.

Based on the WDNR review, the WQT Plan is in general conformance with the WDNR Water Quality Trading Guidance and Wis. Stat 283.84. The WQT plan indicates that the Eleva Strum Joint Sewerage Commission will utilize Water Quality Trading to comply with the effluent limitations for TP for their discharge to the Buffalo River through water quality trading credits generated from streambank stabilization projects. The table below summarizes the total proposed phosphorus credits. These credits are generated and expire on a calendar year basis.

\*\*In the event that this permit is not reissued prior to the expiration date, 238 lbs/yr of credits will be available in subsequent year(s).

The WDNR conditionally approves the WQT Plan as a basis for water quality trading during the WPDES permit term. Because this amendment to the WQT Plan is within the permit term, a modification to the permit and a public notification period is also required. The WDNR has assigned the WQT plan a tracking number of **WQT-2019-0016 (December 2019)** and **Amendment 1 (July 2020)** which will be referenced as such in the modified WPDES permit.
