Water Quality Trading Plan – CONDITIONAL APPROVAL

Dear Mr. Botts:

The Department recently received a water quality trading plan (WQT Plan) for compliance with phosphorus effluent limits at the Janesville Wastewater Utility Plant. The initial plan was received in January of 2022 and updated versions were received in June of 2022, August of 2022, and October of 2022. Based on WDNR review, the final WQT Plan (dated October 2022) is in general conformance with the WDNR Water Quality Trading Guidance and Section 283.84 of the Wisconsin Statutes. The WQT plan proposes installation of over crop practices on agricultural lands, barnyard diversions, and grassed waterways. Credits generated from approved practices result in available credit quantities shown in Table 1. These credits will be incorporated into a modified WPDES permit and will be used to demonstrate compliance with final phosphorus effluent limits.

The Department conditionally approves the WQT Plan as a basis for water quality trading during the next WPDES permit term. This approval is not to be construed as an approval for any activities requiring a permit under ch. 30 or 31, Wis. Stats. The Department has assigned the WQT plan a tracking number of WQT-2022-0007 and will be referenced as such in the draft WPDES permit. The final WQT plan will be included as part of the public notice package for permit reissuance. The draft WPDES permit will include a requirement for an annual trading report and effluent monitoring for total phosphorus.
