PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO REISSUE A WISCONSIN POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (WPDES) PERMIT No.WI-0060453-10-0

Permittee: CITY OF MILTON, 710 S Janesville St, Milton, WI, 53563-0188

Facility Where Discharge Occurs: Milton Wastewater Treatment Facility, 41 NORTH STREET, MILTON, WISCONSIN

Receiving Water And Location: East bank of the Rock River, NE ¼ of SW ¼, Section 14, T4N, R12E in Rock County

Brief Facility Description and Summary of Proposed Changes: The Milton Wastewater Treatment Facility provides treatment to a combination of domestic, commercial, and industrial wastewater. Treatment process consists of an activated sludge system that is designed for nitrification (ammonia removal) and biological phosphorus removal in addition to BOD removal. Alum is added for chemical polishing. Treatment units include raw wastewater screening, extended aeration activated sludge units, final clarifiers, and UV disinfection prior to discharge in the force main to the Rock River. Sludge is aerobically digested, thickened with a gravity belt thickener, and stored in liquid sludge storage tanks before being land applied on DNR-approved sites. The City of Milton discharges in a shared outfall with Consolidated Koshkonong Sanitary District Wastewater Treatment Facility. After a desk top review of all discharge monitoring reports, CMARs, land application reports, and a site visit on February 15, 2023, this facility has been found to be in substantial compliance with their current permit.

The sample frequency for pH has changed to 5/week. Fecal coliform monitoring and limits have been replaced with Escherichia coli (E. coli) monitoring and limits. PFOS and PFOA monitoring once every two months is included in the permit. Total Nitrogen monitoring is included in the permit at an annual frequency in rotating quarters. Total Residual Chlorine has been removed from the permit. Temperature monitoring is no longer included. Chronic WET has been removed from the permit. Sludge monitoring includes annual PFAS monitoring.

The Department has tentatively decided that the above-specified WPDES permit should be reissued.

Limitations and conditions which the Department believes adequately protect the receiving water are included in the proposed permit. Land application of waste shall be done in accordance with permit conditions and applicable codes. All land application sites shall be approved prior to their use. To receive a list of approved sites, or to be notified of potential approvals, contact the above-named basin engineer.

Persons wishing to comment on or object to the proposed permit action, or to request a public hearing, may write to the Department of Natural Resources at the above-named permit drafter's address. All comments or suggestions received no later than 30 days after the publication date of this public notice will be considered along with other information on file in making a final decision regarding the permit. Anyone providing comments in response to this public notice will receive a notification of the Department's final decision when the permit is issued. Where designated as a reviewable surface water discharge permit, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is allowed up to 90 days to submit comments or objections regarding this permit determination. If no comments are received on the proposed permit from anyone, including U.S. EPA, the permit will be issued as proposed.

The Department may schedule a public informational hearing if requested by any person and shall schedule a public informational hearing if a petition requesting a hearing is received from 5 or more persons or if response to this notice indicates significant public interest pursuant to s. 283.49, Wis. Stats. Requests for a public informational hearing shall state the following: the name and address of the person(s) requesting the hearing; the interest in the proposed permit of the person(s) requesting the hearing; the reasons for the request; and the issues proposed to be considered at the hearing.

Information on file for this permit action, including the draft permit, fact sheet and permit application, may be inspected and copied at either the above-named permit drafter's office or the above named basin engineer's office, Monday through Friday (except holidays), between 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Please call the permit drafter or basin engineer for directions to their office location, if necessary. Information on this permit action may also be obtained by calling the permit drafter at (608) 419-4155 or by writing to the Department. Reasonable costs (15 cents per page for copies and 7 cents per page for scanning) will be charged for information in the file other than the public notice, permit and fact sheet.
