PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO MODIFY A WISCONSIN POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (WPDES) PERMIT No.WI-0025020-11-1

Permittee: VILLAGE OF OSCEOLA, Box 217, OSCEOLA, WI, 54020-0217

Facility Where Discharge Occurs: Village of Osceola, 103 Depot Road, Osceola, Wisconsin

Receiving Water And Location: The St. Croix River within the Trout Brook Watershed in the St. Croix River Drainage Basin in Polk County.

Brief Facility Description: The Village of Osceola owns and operates a domestic wastewater treatment system that serves the communities of Osceola and Dresser. The facility is an activated sludge plant, headworks, chemical addition, oxidation ditch, clarifiers and disinfection.

Waste sludge removed from the clarifiers treated by aerobic digestion and hauled to the West Central Wisconsin Biosolids Facility at Ellsworth for further treatment.

Proposed Modification: An error in the effluent monitoring table was found. The limit type for E. coli was incorrectly listed as a "Monthly Average". This has been replaced with the correct limit type of "Geometric Mean – Monthly" which is consistent with s. NR 210.06(2)(a) Wis. Adm. Code. The E. coli table note was also changed to include the disinfection season of April 15 to October 15. This change is consistent with the previous permit term and s. NR 210.06(1)(c) Wis. Adm. Code.

The Department has tentatively decided that the above-specified WPDES permit should be modified.

Persons wishing to comment on or object to the proposed permit action, or to request a public hearing, may write to the Department of Natural Resources at the above-named permit drafter's address. All comments or suggestions received no later than 30 days after the publication date of this public notice will be considered along with other information on file in making a final decision regarding the permit. Anyone providing comments in response to this public notice will receive a notification of the Department's final decision when the permit is issued. Where designated as a reviewable surface water discharge permit, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is allowed up to 90 days to submit comments or objections regarding this permit determination. If no comments are received on the proposed permit from anyone, including U.S. EPA, the permit will be issued as proposed.

The Department may schedule a public informational hearing if requested by any person and shall schedule a public informational hearing if a petition requesting a hearing is received from 5 or more persons or if response to this notice indicates significant public interest pursuant to s. 283.49, Wis. Stats. Requests for a public informational hearing shall state the following: the name and address of the person(s) requesting the hearing; the interest in the proposed permit of the person(s) requesting the hearing; the reasons for the request; and the issues proposed to be considered at the hearing.

Information on file for this permit action, including the draft permit, fact sheet and permit application, may be inspected and copied at either the above-named permit drafter's office or the above named basin engineer's office, Monday through Friday (except holidays), between 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Please call the permit drafter or basin engineer for directions to their office location, if necessary. Information on this permit action may also be obtained by calling the permit drafter at (715) 635-4131 or by writing to the Department. Reasonable costs (15 cents per page for copies and 7 cents per page for scanning) will be charged for information in the file other than the public notice, permit and fact sheet.
