PUBLIC NOTICE OF INTENT TO REISSUE A WISCONSIN POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (WPDES) PERMIT No.WI-0025569-10-0

Permittee: Village of Stratford, PO Box 12, Stratford, WI, 54484-0012

Facility Where Discharge Occurs: Stratford Wastewater Treatment Facility, 119601 North Street, Stratford, WI 54484

Receiving Water And Location: Connor Mill Creek to the Big Eau Pleine River in Lower Big Eau Pleine River Watershed of Central Wisconsin River Basin in Marathon County

Brief Facility Description: The Village of Stratford owns and operates a 0.235 million gallons per day (MGD) treatment facility with discharge to Connor Mill Creek, a tributary to the Big Eau Pleine River. The actual annual average flow in 2025 was 0.170 MGD. The facility treats domestic wastewater from the Village of Stratford and industrial wastewater from Grassland Stamping Solutions (formally General Shoe Supplies). Wastewater is treated using a Huber Rotomat screen, vortex grit removal, two aeration basins, two final clarifiers, four aerobic digestors and addition of ferric chloride for phosphorus removal. Sludge is dewatered using a Somat screw press, along with polymer addition for sludge dewatering prior to land application on Department approved fields. Beginning in 2023, ferric chloride addition commenced based on real time effluent ortho-P values in order to optimize chemical usage and prevent effluent toxicity. The Department approved the water quality trading (WQT) plan (WQT-2024-0031) submitted by the permittee as a way to demonstrate compliance with water quality based effluent limits (WQBELs) for total phosphorus. The plan provides calculations and a table that shows the amount of phosphorus credits that will be available each year.

The Department has tentatively decided that the above-specified WPDES permit should be reissued.

Limitations and conditions which the Department believes adequately protect the receiving water are included in the proposed permit. Land application of waste shall be done in accordance with permit conditions and applicable codes. All land application sites shall be approved prior to their use. To receive a list of approved sites, or to be notified of potential approvals, contact the above-named basin engineer.

Persons wishing to comment on or object to the proposed permit action, or to request a public hearing, may write to the Department of Natural Resources at the above-named permit drafter's address. All comments or suggestions received no later than 30 days after the publication date of this public notice will be considered along with other information on file in making a final decision regarding the permit. Anyone providing comments in response to this public notice will receive a notification of the Department's final decision when the permit is issued. Where designated as a reviewable surface water discharge permit, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is allowed up to 90 days to submit comments or objections regarding this permit determination. If no comments are received on the proposed permit from anyone, including U.S. EPA, the permit will be issued as proposed.

The Department may schedule a public informational hearing if requested by any person and shall schedule a public informational hearing if a petition requesting a hearing is received from 5 or more persons or if response to this notice indicates significant public interest pursuant to s. 283.49, Wis. Stats. Requests for a public informational hearing shall state the following: the name and address of the person(s) requesting the hearing; the interest in the proposed permit of the person(s) requesting the hearing; the reasons for the request; and the issues proposed to be considered at the hearing.

Information on file for this permit action, including the draft permit, fact sheet and permit application, may be inspected and copied at either the above-named permit drafter's office or the above named basin engineer's office, Monday through Friday (except holidays), between 9:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Please call the permit drafter or basin engineer for directions to their office location, if necessary. Reasonable costs (15 cents per page for copies and 7 cents per page for scanning) will be charged for information in the file other than the public notice, permit and fact sheet.
