

Login Changes To The Water Withdrawal Reporting System

In Dec. 2025, the Wisconsin Access Management System (WAMS) login portal was replaced by MyWisconsin ID. Users will now need a MyWisconsin ID to complete water withdrawal reports and cannot use WAMS.

What is MyWisconsin ID?

MyWisconsin ID is the single sign-on account platform replacing multiple state logon processes. It is designed to give you access to multiple state resources without the burden of having to remember multiple IDs and passwords.

What Does the Change Mean for Me?


- Beginning Dec. 2025, you will need to register for a MyWisconsin ID account to complete the online water withdrawal reports. WAMS will no longer be used.
- Only the login process is changing. There are no changes to the reporting process itself.

How Do I Register for a MyWisconsin ID?

- Go to <https://apps.wisconsin.gov> and follow the instructions to self-register.
- If you already have a MyWisconsin ID through another state agency, you should not create another. You will sign in with your existing MyWisconsin ID credentials.
- You will need your Owner Operator Number to link your account to MyWisconsin ID. Email DNRWaterUseRegistration@wisconsin.gov or call **608-266-2299** if you do not know your Owner Operator Number.

How will I know it's Time to Sign in Using MyWisconsin ID Instead of WAMS?

- The DNR will send a GovDelivery email before and after the change takes effect.
- You will also notice a new login screen. The WAMS screen shows Wisconsin's shape and the letters "WAMS" in the top left corner. The MyWisconsin ID screen has the Wisconsin State Seal and a primarily yellow background.




Creating A MyWisconsin ID
