Re: City of Racine water diversion proposal

The League of Women Voters of Wisconsin advocates for denial of a request by the City of Racine for diversion of an average of 7.0 million gallons of water from Lake Michigan daily to meet the water needs of a private entity in the Village of Mount Pleasant. In addition, we caution that this request may be followed by another proposal for increased diversion since experts indicate larger volumes of 10 to 15.8 million gallons per day is common for such facilities (financial analyst, David Hsieh).

As a member of the multi-state League of Women Voters of the Lake Michigan Region, the Wisconsin League supports preserving and enhancing the environmental integrity and quality of the Great Lakes-St. Lawrence River Ecosystem. We support the Great Lakes Compact, a legal, "responsibility pact" that sets rules for the withdrawal of water from the Lakes, and gives bordering communities a say in any decisions to divert water to areas outside the Great Lakes Basin.

The water of the Great Lakes is not an infinite resource. Rain and streams replenish only one percent of the Lakes' water each year. The results of over-usage are already seen in the drop in water level in Lake Michigan and other Lakes. The Lakes are a gift of the retreating glaciers, and once depleted they will not be restored.

We urge you to examine carefully in light of the requirements of the Great Lakes Compact and potential harm to the environmental health of the region:

- Racine's application is for a private purpose, rather than a public purpose as required by the Compact. As a straddling community interested in the Foxconn proposal, the Village of Mount Pleasant should be the applicant.
- -Foxconn indicates a loss of 2 million gallons of water through evaporation each day. Should multiple applicants for diversion expect such losses, the cumulative effect of these losses could further lower Lake levels.
- The future public need for water in the Village of Mount Pleasant may be compromised by this sizeable diversion to a non-public entity. This request for diversion on behalf of a water-intensive, non-public entity threatens future public water use, especially if the entity increases its footprint and need for water.
- Foxconn, the proposed end user of diverted water, intends to send as much as 60 to 70 percent of withdrawn water back to Lake Michigan with no enforceable, rigorous requirements for measuring contaminants in returned waters.
- Waters returned to Lake Michigan must be pretreated to assure that toxins used in LCD panel production do
 not enter Lake Michigan. Among these toxins is the cancer-causing chemical solvent, benzene. Also included is a
 host of toxic heavy metals such as cadmium, chromium, zinc, indium, and copper which pose a variety of
 significant health threats.

The Compact requires that any evaluation of a proposed diversion consider not only individual impacts of this proposed diversion but the potential cumulative impacts of all future diversions based on the precedent set

here. Countless future requests from municipalities in all eight Great Lakes states and the two Canadian provinces that border the Lakes threaten the future of this commonly held and legally protected resource.

The League of Women Voters of Wisconsin believes water conservation should be a highest priority for all governments in the basin. We urge you not to approve the current proposal in the absence of firm, complete and detailed plans by the City of Racine, the Village of Mount Pleasant and Foxconn for minimizing both the certain and the potential environmental and health impacts of the proposed water diversion.

The League of Women Voters Lake Michigan Region (LWVLMR) is an Inter-League Organization made up of 63 local Leagues of Women Voters within the Lake Michigan watershed and regional planning areas, along with the four state Leagues.

We advocate that you refuse the proposal by the City of Racine to divert an average of 7 million gallons of water from Lake Michigan daily to meet Fox Conn's, a private foreign industrial company, water needs. The Great Lakes Compact states, "All the Water so transferred shall be used solely for Public Water Supply Purposes within the Straddling Community."

LWVLMR supports the Great Lakes Compact, an eight state and two Canadian "leadership pact" that sets rules for the withdrawal and return of water from the Lakes. We support preserving and enhancing the environmental integrity and quality of the Great Lakes-St Lawrence River Ecosystem.

We urge you to examine carefully whether Fox Conn has met the requirements of the Great Lakes Compact. Clearly, we are concerned that the Fox Conn diversion application is for industrial use and has not adequately provided enough detail about the amount and the quality of the water that will be returned to the city of Racine and Lake Michigan.

Fox Conn has not implemented sufficient conservation practices in its other industrial locations. Wisconsin has also bypassed requirements of environmental impact statements and has dismissed wetland precautions in an area of recent costly flooding in Racine County.

Keep in mind that the Fox Conn proposal is the first of its kind you are considering. What happens to this proposal will set a precedent for countless future requests from municipalities in Wisconsin as well as all eight Great Lakes states and two Canadian provinces that border the lakes.

We believe water conservation and water pollution prevention should be a high priority of all governments in the basin. We urge you **not** to approve the current proposal for a private **industrial** company's use of Lake Michigan water due to the **non-public use**, the **30-40% loss of water** to be discharged, and the absence of a complete and detailed plan to remove the **toxic chemicals** in the water discharged from Fox Conn to the City of Racine and into Lake Michigan.

My name is Taylor Stevens, a student from the University of Wisconsin Whitewater here today to urge the Wisconsin DNR to oppose the Racine Water Diversion Application for Foxconn development. Racine has requested to divert up to 7 million gallons a day to the diversion area. Just so we are all clear, Racine can currently legally draw up to 60 million gallons a day. They are now asking for the additional 7 million gallons. Under the EPA website, on the page "Great Lakes Facts and Figures" it states on the third line that, "the Great Lakes are the largest surface freshwater system on the Earth. Only the polar ice caps contain more fresh water." This precious freshwater can be and will be significantly altered by the introduction and inconsistencies of the Foxconn operation. We need to ask, where is this water going and what is it being utilized for?

However, Foxconn would not be possible without the intervention of our governor, Scott Walker. Under his new 2017 bill titled, "Electronics and Information Technology Manufacturing Zone," he outlines a few new regulations and inconsistencies to be laid out. Under current law, all state agencies are required to create an environmental impact statement for every recommendation or proposal that will affect the quality of the human environment. Under this bill an environmental impact statement "for a new manufacturing facility within an electronics and information technology manufacturing zone," or Foxconn, is not a major action or required. In addition, under current federal law it states that activities that involve the discharge or fill material to be released in navigable water, or "waters of the United States" must comply with guidelines set by the EPA and be issued a permit by the US Army Corps of Engineers. As the DNR, the current law requires the you to "issue wetland general permits for discharges of dredged or fill material into certain federal and nonfederal wetlands." Under the Great Lakes compact - section straddling counties, the department may approve a proposal if under section e, "the proposal will not endanger the integrity of the Great Lakes basin ecosystem based upon a determination that the proposal will have no adverse impact on the Great Lakes basin ecosystem." Without these previous regulations, how can we determine the true threat? Under this technology bill, Walker states that a "person may, without a permit, discharge dredged material or fill material into a non federal wetland that is located in an electronics and information technology manufacturing zone." This company is no different than any company that has come before us today. If a production as large as Foxconn plans to take gallons out of the Great Lakes everyday, and now has fewer regulations than any company in this area before, can we truly say that we know this is safe? We need to admit and investigate inconsistencies so that we can face problems head on before they happen.

The main motive in most of these corporation situations is always jobs. Jobs provide for families but what happens when technology takes over and jobs are lost to robotic machinery? Tuan is the Honorary Chairman for Foxconn and states in a press conference that, "We will reduce our total workforce to less than 50,000 people by the end of this year, from some 60,000 staff at the end of 2017," according to Nikkei.com. 10,000 jobs are proposed to be lost to the robotic industry and that number is proposed to increase. What happens to American jobs then?

As a young student who aspires to teach my future students about the great lakes and rich history we have here in Wisconsin, I urge you to deny the Racine Water Diversion Application and stop this production before it gets any further.

Public Comments of Jodi Habush Sinykin, Of Counsel, Midwest Environmental Advocates Re: City of Racine's Application for a Diversion under the Great Lakes Compact

Thank you for this opportunity to speak before you. As an environmental attorney who has championed, watch-dogged and studied the Great Lakes Compact going on 14 years, I feel a sense of responsibility to comment on the instant diversion proposal and the harmful precedent it may set for the Great Lakes Compact.

The Great Lakes Compact is nothing to take lightly, as its enactment was a historic accomplishment at both the regional and national level and celebrated as a means to safeguard the world class freshwater resources of our magnificent Great Lakes. A centerpiece of the Compact, then and now, is its Ban on Diversions, reflecting the region's determination to prohibit the transfer of Great Lakes water outside the basin unless a diversion request can meet the narrowly defined exceptions outlined in the provisions and definitions of the Compact.

It is here where the City of Racine's present request for a diversion falls short.

Section 4.9.1 of the Compact plainly states the operative rule governing the "straddling community" exception as follows: "A proposal to transfer Great Lakes water within a Straddling Community but outside the basin, shall be excepted from the Compact's ban on diversions provided that all the water so transferred shall be used solely for Public Water Supply Purposes within the Straddling Community."

It is evident on the facts that Racine's application does not and cannot meet this core threshold requirement. Why? Because the 7 MGD of Great Lakes water requested for transfer to the Foxconn facility in Mt. Pleasant will <u>not</u> be used in a manner consistent with the intent and spirit of the Compact's definition of "Public Water Supply Purposes," which the authors of the Compact were careful to delineate and to which the Great Lakes states and provinces agreed.

Specifically, Article 1 of the Compact defines Public Water Supply Purposes as "water distributed to the public...serving a group of <u>largely residential</u> customers that may also serve industrial, commercial and other institutional operators."

Here, then, is the rub, because "a group of largely residential customers" is NOT—I repeat not— who will be served by the 7 MGD sought by the city of Racine. Rather, the complete opposite is true. Racine will use the majority, if not the entirety of, the diverted Great Lakes water to serve the industrial needs of a single *private* foreign industrial entity--Foxconn.

Racine's application thus represents a test of our state's and region's commitment to the Great Lakes Compact. As we know from every known sport, whether professional, recreational or Olympic, the integrity of the competition's outcome rests upon strict compliance with the meaning and intent of the rules agreed to by the participants. The Compact is no different; its integrity is on the line.

Which is why Wisconsin should not be in such a rush to approve Racine's diversion for Foxconn. Fudging Compact criteria, allowing a key definition's plain meaning to slide, sets a harmful precedent at a time when the Compact is still new and being tested. And at a time when global trends and conditions dictate that our region undertake a conscientious, careful stewardship of our freshwater supply. To ensure a Great Lakes Compact that is strong and sustainable, we need to honor its language and intent at every opportunity. That opportunity is here and now—Wisconsin, be a Compact champion.

Thank you for the opportunity to speak today. My name is James Penczykowski. I am a fourth generation citizen of the USA and the great State of Wisconsin. I was born in Racine, Wisconsin and raised just a few miles from here on Wood Road in the Town of Somers. I spent the first 31 years of my life within the watershed of Lake Michigan. My father and his father fished in this Great Lake; somewhere in the family archives is a photo of my grandfather proudly showing off a sturgeon he caught from this lake. My father loved fishing for perch from this lake. This Great Lake contains the melted remains of the last ice age. We do not have a means of replacing what we take from or despoil in this Great Lake. Natural processes that predate all of us and nature's God have gifted us with a resource that we squander at our risk and the risk of our children's children's children's children's children's children's children's children –the proverbial 7 generations.

If this is a true hearing and not a token gesture to appease the letter of the law, then please consider doing the following:

- 1) determine what industrial processes this treasured water resource will be put to and if heavy metals or other toxic substances would leach into the waste water, then **deny** the use of Great Lakes water;
- 2) <u>all</u> industrial processes used in the manufacture of products in this area should come in for a fine-toothed comb inspection <u>open to the public</u> before any permits are granted and there should be no excuse of "proprietary" processes to hide behind;
- 3) if you can then <u>reliably confirm</u> that waste water from these industrial processes will not be contaminated with heavy metals or other toxic substances, then meter the waste water coming back into the municipal waste water treatment facility to ensure that every last drop not lost to normal evaporation is recaptured so that Great Lake water levels are not adversely affected;
- 4) require that all these new industrial users of this Great Lake water resource pay the <u>retail</u> cost of the water used, that is, the same rate that every residential single-family home owner in the municipal water system pays. This may be the only direct benefit that many of them may ever see from this industrial expansion into some of the finest arable land in the world.
