Dear Wisconsin Driller/Pump Installer Training Provider:

Revisions to Wisconsin Administrative Code Chapter NR 146 are expected to go into effect in the upcoming 2026 calendar year. These revisions will not affect continuing education requirements until the 2027 calendar year. However, input received from advisory council members throughout the rule revision process raised questions on how training for 2026 might begin to address perceived issues within the Wisconsin well drilling, pump installing and property transfer well inspection communities. Please consider how training that you offer in 2026 for continuing education credit can be instrumental in improving knowledge, integrity and professionalism within our Wisconsin regulated well drilling community.

APPLYING FOR PRE-APPROVAL

You are encouraged to apply for continuing education credit approval. Training topics and subtopics are reviewed for pertinence to Wisconsin drillers and pump installers before approval is given. Approval criteria and instruction documents linked below explain in detail what is required and how to apply to receive Wisconsin DNR pre-approval.
