How to Apply for High Capacity Dewatering Wells Online


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Get set up to apply online (first time only)

- 1. Get a WAMS ID if you don't already have one. See the instructions for getting a WAMS ID.
- 2. Go to https://dnrx.wisconsin.gov/wateruse/external V3/Application/ to finish getting set up.

Fill out an online application

- 1. Log in with your WAMS ID at https://dnrx.wisconsin.gov/wateruse/external V3/Application/
- 2. Click Dewatering Applications at the top.




3. Click Start a New Application (blue button)



- 4. Fill in the information in the white fields.
 - o Latitude and longitude should be roughly the center of your project site.
 - Tips for reporting coordinates (latitude and longitude) can be found at https://dnr.wisconsin.gov/topic/Wells/locatingWithGPS.html
- 5. At the bottom, add attachments (engineering plan map, well construction diagram, discharge drawing, etc.).
 - Choose the Document Type
 - o Click the Choose File or Browse button
 - o Click Upload




6. When you are finished, click <u>Save</u> to save the application and finish later, or click <u>Pay Fee and Submit Application</u>. You will be directed to the US Bank website to pay the application fee.




Pay the Application Fee and Submit the Application

- 1. Pay Fee and Submit Application will take you to the payment screens.
 - o Credit Card There is a convenience fee. The total will be \$508.75
 - Checking or Savings Enter your checking account number and routing number. The total will be \$500.00.
- 2. Fill in your payment information
- 3. Click the Confirm (red button) at the bottom.



4. Click <u>Continue to State Agency Website</u> (red button). You will be redirected back to the Water Use site. Click <u>Dewatering Applications</u> at the top to see any applications you have submitted.



Please note that WPDES general permit applications need to be submitted separately at <u>Water permit applications</u> | <u>Wisconsin DNR</u>.

How to Get a WAMS ID

- 1. Go to http://on.wisconsin.gov
- 2. Click Self Registration
- 3. Scroll down and click Accept



- 4. Fill in the required information.
 - Note: WAMS IDs must belong to an individual person, and not shared among a business.
 - Skip the addresses and just fill in the required fields: First Name, Last Name, Email
 - c. The user ID must have between 5-20 characters. The password must have between 7-20 characters and contain a combination of letters, plus either numbers or special characters.



5. After you have submitted your registration, you will receive an email at the address you provided. The message will contain a link to activate your account. Click the link and enter the user ID and password you created. After logging in, the screen will show that you successfully created and activated your WAMS account.
