





New Heat Exchange Technology

- Exchanger submerged in well
- Water is circulated past heat exchanger
- Closed loop moves fluid from building to exchanger
- Requires variance to HEX requirements



Policy on Systems

- Regulated as a HE drillhole
- Variance will be required
- Conditions:
 - Must be placed within an NR 812 compliant well drilled by a licensed well driller
 - Must use an approved pitless adaptor installed by a licensed pump installer
 - May only pump water within a single aquifer
 - May only use water as HE fluid
 - Drop pipe must meet NR 812 requirements




Mailings to Owners



- Replaced Wells
 - 320 letters sent mid-November
 - Next mailing: March/April 2024
- Well Labels
 - 13,054 letters sent mid-October
 - Last sent Summer 2022
 - Next mailing: April/May 2024
 - Switched to paper labels from the old stickers

Moving to mailings in Spring and Fall each year.





Annual Report Letters – Well Drillers

2021 & 2022 Letters went out in 2023.

Future letters will be sent in February/March for the prior calendar year.



Two letter model will continue.

"Needs Improvement" letter for those bordering on a concerning level of late/missing work (33-64%) Notice of Noncompliance letter for those exceeding 65% late/missing work

Field staff input prior to sending letters to avoid issuing letters when not appropriate.

First Year of E-reporting WCRs

Total WCRs completed in 2023 (as of 1/16/2024): 8901
Total WCRs completed in 2022: 9539
Total WARs completed in 2023 (as of 1/16/2024): 3305
Total WARs completed in 2022: 3495

10 licensees stopped reporting in 2023 5 of those only submitted 1 WCR in 2022.




PVC Casing in Bedrock





Private Water Variances

2022 Variances Issued = 325

- Landfill Variances: 169
- Other Variances (setbacks, construction, etc.): 156

2023 Variances Issued = 323

- Landfill Variances: 190
- Other Variances (setbacks, construction, etc.): 133



2023 Enforcement

Primary Enforcement:

- Notice of Noncompliance (NON)
- Total NONs = 64 (+8% from 2022)
 - Field Staff = 10 (-55% from 2022)
 - Fry/Reporting = 54 (+245% from 2022)

Secondary Enforcement:

- Notice of Violation (NOV Env. Enforcement)
- Total NOVs = 12 (+400% from 2022)
 - Had reporting issues = 11 (92%)
 - Unlicensed individual = 3 (25%)



2023 Enforcement

Citation Summary:

16 Total Citations

- January-March
 - 7 citations issued
- April-June
 - 2 citations issued
- July-September
 - 7 citations issued
- October-December
 - None



Citation Background:

- 6 enforcement cases
- 5 individuals/businesses
- \$867.50 per citation
- Failure to submit true and accurate report – 4
- Failure to collect required water samples – 2
- Failure to obtain license 8
- All but 2 paid or pled no-contest
